## Context

The joint EU DG Reform – Council of Europe project “Strengthening child friendly justice through effective cooperation and coordination among different Barnahus-type services in the regions of Spain” is implemented by the Council of Europe in close collaboration with the Ministry of Social Rights and Agenda 2030 during the period of 06/07/2022-05/07/2024. It is co-financed by the EU Structural Support Reform Programme. Barnahus is a leading European model for a child-friendly multidisciplinary and interagency response to child sexual exploitation and abuse.

The project will support the Spanish Government in improving relevant legislation, policies and tools to introduce the Barnahus model and in strengthening the capacity of relevant professionals working for and with children. The project is divided into two main components:

1. Improving the legislative and policy framework to introduce the Barnahus model in Spanish regions;
2. Strengthening capacities of relevant professionals.

The project also foresees the organisation of awareness-raising activities and the exchange of good practices. This conference constitutes the first training on the Barnahus model and its implementation in the different territories of the country.
