#### **ENLARGED PARTIAL AGREEMENT ON CULTURAL ROUTES** OF THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE (EPA)

Established in 2010, the Enlarged Partial Agreement on Cultural Routes (EPA) follows the Council of Europe's policy quidelines, decides the programme strategy and awards "Council of Europe Cultural Route" certification. It is open to member and non-member States of the Council of Europe aiming at providing political support for national, regional and local initiatives to promote European citizenship through cultural heritage and sustainable tourism. The Secretariat of the EPA is located at the European Institute of Cultural Routes in Luxembourg.


