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AS A VICTIM OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING, YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO FREE LEGAL AID REGARDLESS OF YOUR FINANCIAL STATUS

Contact the Free Legal Aid Service, which exists within every basic court.

The assigned free legal aid includes legal advice, drafting documents, and representation before competent authorities, which is provided by a qualified representative – a lawyer.

The lawyer will accompany you through all stages of the proceedings, provide assistance in protecting your rights, and in filing a property claim.

- ▶ You work under coercion, in harsh conditions.
- ▶ Your passport or other personal documents have been taken away, your movement or communication has been restricted.
