GEC-MIG: Mandate

✓ Gender Equality Strategy 2018-2023:

NSFIL DE L'EUROPE

- Objective 5 on 'Protect the rights of migrant, refugee and asylum-seeking women and girls'
- Mention of an 'update' of R(79)10 concerning women migrants

✓ Terms of Reference of GEC-MIG (CM meeting of 4) November 2019):

'draft a recommendation on migrant and refugee women on the basis of **R(79)10** concerning women migrants and of an **analysis of needs and gaps** that need to be addressed'.

GEC-MIG Working Methods (1)

- 2 Meetings of GEC-MIG in 2020: 1-2 October and 14-15 December (Strasbourg) (tbc) + 2 meetings in 2021
- All 47 member states invited to participate; 8 member states with participation costs covered: Austria, France, Greece, Italy, Malta, Portugal, Serbia, Slovak Republic.
- ✓All participants and observers in the GEC are observers in GEC-MIG
- Support from an expert (Louise Hooper) to give advice and help drafting.



GEC-MIG Working Methods (2)

✓ GEC survey May-July 2020 – 19 contributions

✓ Guidance given at July 2020 GEC meeting

- Internal consultation meeting with different sectors of the CoE on 17.09.20
- Exchanges with different stakeholders at each meeting of GEC-MIG
- Reporting to the GEC after each GEC-MIG meeting
- ✓ Informal consultation of relevant stakeholders on draft at the end of the process
- Draft new recommendation to be adopted by the GEC and subsequently the Committee of Ministers

Building on the Council of Europe Gender Equality Strategy 2018-2023 and its Strategic Objective 5 "Protect the rights of migrant, refugee and asylum-seeking women and girls", the Drafting Committee on Migrant Women (GEC-MIG), a subordinate body to the Gender Equality Commission (GEC), was tasked by the Committee of Ministers to draft a Recommendation on migrant and refugee women on the basis of Recommendation Rec(79)10 concerning women migrants and of an analysis of needs and gaps that need to be addressed. GEC-MIG is composed of representatives of 8 member states (Austria, France,

Greece, Italy, Malta, Portugal, Serbia, Slovak Republic) whose expenses are borne by the Council of Europe. All member states may send additional representatives, without defrayal of expenses, to the meetings of the Drafting Committee. Two meetings are foreseen each year of the GEC-MIG mandate (2020-2021).

- ✓ Many changes in the last 40 years
- Some issues initially identified for the new recommendation are covered but may need updating
- ✓ Some issues are not covered
