

Juvenile Justice in Italy

Principal features of Juvenile Justice in Italy:

- Minimise harsh punishment and labelling of young people
- Tailor-made educational programmes
- Positive educational value and empowerment.
- Involve families and communities in reintegration.
- Legislation on minor offenders (Presidential Decree N. 448/88)
 - ensures protection of children's rights
 - implements principles outlined above

The Right Tools

- individual and collective learning and empowerment of people working together on specific issues and users;
- ability to identify and monitor the warning signs of individual and social unrest leading to deviance;
- reflective learning from experience;
- designing of shared models of possible courses of action.

- CREATE ENVIRONMENTS where young people can tell their stories, and get to know them more directly to provide tools for greater protection and more appropriate support
- INNOVATE SERVICES AND INTERVENTIONS by building on past experiences but with full openness to what is new, adopting a listening stance in order to understand the issues and problems of youngsters
