
From Akkon to Marienburg (today Feldioara) and after in 12 other european countries

Grandmaster Herman von Salza (1209 – 1239)

The Order of the German Knights or Teutonic Order was foundet in the Holy Land, in Akkon 1190 as **Order of Brothers of the German House of Saint Mary in Jerusalem**. In 1199 this order was transformated in the **Ordo Teutonicus or Order of the German Knights**.


The first stop in Europe was in Transylvania between 1211 - 1225







- The Marienburg was the headquarter of the Order after Venice
- Was destroyed in the WW2
- Thepolisch Goverment started the reconstruction
- 1997 the Castle was the Teutonic Castle inscribed in the World Heritage List of UNESCO



The German Knights in Poland and in the 3 baltic countries, Lithuania, Estonia & Latvia














Karte 8: Der Deutschorden in Südwestdeutschland vor der Französischen Revolution
