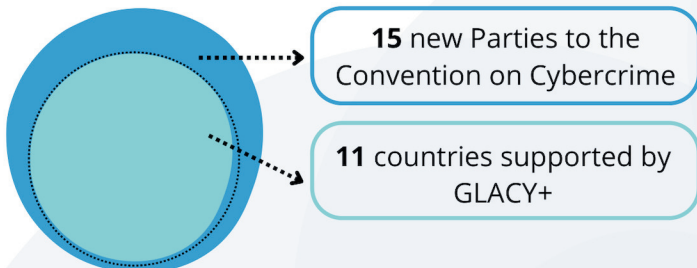
Project Impact (March 2016 - November 2023)
