




# GLACY projects

2016-2024

**Global Action on Cybercrime Enhanced (GLACY-e)** is a joint project of the European Union and the Council of Europe aimed at strengthening capacities of States worldwide to apply legislation on cybercrime and electronic evidence, enhancing their abilities for effective international cooperation in this area, and fostering South-South cooperation.
