- *Council of Europe contribution to the international order and global governance and to the SDGs*

The Committee of Ministers

1. welcomed the outcome of the reflection process on the contribution of the Council of Europe to the international order and global governance, as well as to the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) carried out so far, as reflected in document CM(2022)84-final, which has focused on the external relations of the Council of Europe, including its relations with observer States and with international organisations and non-member States which share the Council of Europe's principles of human rights, the rule of law and democracy, and on the promotion of the Council of Europe's instruments and bodies open to non-member States;

2. endorsed the proposals outlined in the document CM(2022)84-final with a view to pursuing the ongoing work in the field of external relations.
