#### 1<sup>st</sup> meeting 25–27 September 2024

#### LIST OF ITEMS DISCUSSED AND DECISIONS TAKEN

#### ABRIDGED REPORT

 The Ad hoc Multidisciplinary Group on the Environment (GME) held its 1<sup>st</sup> meeting in Strasbourg, 25-27 September 2024. The meeting was opened by the Secretariat and chaired by Mr Rafael BENITEZ, Director of Social Rights, Health and Environment, until the election of the Chair of the GME.

Mr Gianluca ESPOSITO, Director General of Human Rights and Rule of Law delivered a statement to the GME.

- 2. The GME adopted the agenda as it appears in Appendix I. The list of participants appears in Appendix II.
- 3. The GME elected Ms Maria DIAMANTOPOULOU (Greece) as Chair, Ms Nino LATSABIDZE (Georgia) as Vice-Chair, Ms Charlotte BLONDEL (France), Ms Agnes GABOR-HOSSZU (Hungary), and Ms Michelle DUIN (the Netherlands) as three Bureau members in accordance with the Resolution CM/res(2021)3.
- 4. The GME took note of the terms of reference, mandate, deliverables and deadlines as set out in document <u>GME(2024)1.</u>
- 5. The GME held an exchange of views with the Chair of the Council of Europe Steering Committee on Human Rights (CDDH), Ms Krista OINONEN.
- 6. The GME held an exchange of views with the Chair of the Council of Europe Parliamentary Assembly Committee on Social Affairs, Health and Sustainable Development, Mr Simon MOUTQUIN.
- 7. The GME considered a Compendium of the Council of Europe activities on the environment (document <u>GME(2024)2</u>) and took note of other related developments in the Council of Europe.
- 8. The GME held an exchange of views concerning the challenges of the triple planetary crisis at national level on the basis of the written contributions received to the questionnaire set out in document <u>GME(2024)6</u> and other oral contributions made during the meeting. Delegations were invited to submit their written contributions to the Secretariat (<u>GME@coe.int</u>) by 11 October 2024.
- 9. The GME undertook the preparation of a Council of Europe Strategy on the Environment and held a preliminary exchange of view on the basis of the proposed elements for the elaboration of the Council of Europe Strategy on the Environment set out in document <u>GME(2024)3</u> and in the light of the above-mentioned Compendium of the Council of Europe activities on the environment

(document <u>GME(2024)2</u>). Delegations were invited to submit any additional comments or observations to document <u>GME(2024)3</u> to the Secretariat (<u>GME@coe.int</u>) by 11 October 2024. The comments should follow as applicable the following structures: a) General comments to the strategy and the document, b) comments on the introductory section of the document, and c) comments to the specific sections of the Appendix of the document.

- 10. The GME considered the requests of the observer status formulated by the Center for International Environmental Law (CIEL), the Global Network for Human Rights and the Environment (GNHRE) and the Green Rights Coalition as set out respectively in documents <u>GME(2024)7</u>, <u>GME(2024)8</u>, <u>GME(2024)9</u> and decided by unanimity to grant the observer status and invited them to the hearing which will be held at its next meeting.
- 11. The GME decided to hold its 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting in Strasbourg, on 9-11 December 2024 and adopted the preliminary draft agenda as set out in Appendix III. The GME also took note that the 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting will be held in Strasbourg, on 11-13 February 2025.
- 12. Any other business, Ms Merike LINNAMÄGI, Chair of the Bern Convention Standing Committee, provided an update on the developments regarding the protection status of the wolf in the European Union. The Secretariat also provided an update regarding the activities of the Landscape Convention.
- 13. The GME adopted the present abridged report.
