#### **ABRIDGED REPORT**

- 1. The Ad hoc Multidisciplinary Group on the Environment (GME) held its 4<sup>th</sup> meeting in Strasbourg on 10-12 March 2025. The meeting was chaired by Ms Maria DIAMANTOPOULOU.
- 2. The GME adopted the report of the 3<sup>rd</sup> GME meeting and the agenda of the 4<sup>th</sup> meeting as it appears in Appendix I. The list of participants appears in Appendix II.
- The GME took note of the statement of Mr Rafael BENITEZ, Director of Social Rights, Health and Environment, regarding developments in the Council of Europe of interest for the GME, in particular the state of preparation of the environment related decisions for the Committee of Ministers ministerial session in Luxembourg on 14 May 2025.
- 4. The GME examined and adopted the draft Council of Europe Strategy on the Environment as it appears in Appendix III, and agreed to submit it to the Committee of Ministers in pursuance of its Terms of Reference.
- 5. The GME examined a preliminary draft of the Action Plan, took note of the fact that the text is a living document, and instructed the Secretariat to update it following comments made at the meeting and received by email by Thursday 13 March 2025. It agreed to transmit the draft Action Plan as it appears in Appendix IV to the Committee of Ministers in pursuance of its Terms of Reference.
- 6. The GME decided to hold its 5<sup>th</sup> meeting in hybrid format, online and in Strasbourg, on 2-4 December 2025, and adopted the preliminary draft agenda as set out in Appendix V. The GME instructed the Bureau to make a proposal on the length of the meeting.
- 7. The GME adopted the present abridged report.
