## Creating a narrative

### Summary

The Scientific Committee of the Association for the Cultural Route of St. Olav Ways (ACSOW) has literally taken a step back in establishing a platform for research and development on deciding to create a narrative on which to base their future work.

The narrative will focus on two aspects:

- The historical aspect, as a basis for the authenticity of the St. Olav Route
- The modern aspect, as a way to enhance memory, history and European heritage as part of present life.

Their work will be presented at a one-day-conference as a part of the General Assembly in March 2019.
