Summary

The project aims at improving the skills of the members of the EU Routes of Ceramics in the creation and development of new touristic products.

It includes the realization of a cycle of webinars about sustainable tourism linked to cultural heritage, presenting both theoretical and successful experiences. The first webinar was held last 30 November and was dedicated to the combination of ceramics and food.

The second one will explore the possibilities of touristic products linked to the cultural heritage, while the third one will be dedicated to digital tools for the promotion of the Route.

Webinars are free and open to the representatives of the members of the Route, local operators, museums, associations and all stakeholders who can be active in the realization of future touristic products.
