

Café of Europe 2022 - Thermal Villages: Rural Development Opportunities



Summary

The 2022 Café of Europe, entitled "Thermal Villages: Rural Development Opportunities", was held in the Portalera Thermal Laundry in Caldes de Montbui and online.

Caldes de Monbui has developed many uses for thermal waters, from being a key ingredient in local gastronomic specialities to irrigating crops in the fields with waste thermal water. This is an ancient tradition which has been reinstated after a restoration project in the "thermal orchards". The event venue was one of several historic thermal laundries in the town, used until relatively recently for the town's washing, and whose waters irrigate the crops nearby.

The Café of Europe heard from Patricia Carmona, UNWTO Programme Officer about the UNWTO's "Best Rural Villages" programme as well as about projects in small thermal settlements:

Caldes de Montbui (Spain) and the wider Catalunyan region - Association of Thermal Villages in Catalunya, La Garriga (Barcelona), El Vendrell (Tarragona), Caldes de Malavella (Girona), Saint-Paul-lès-Dax (France). Experts from S. Pedro do Sul (Portugal), INORDE - Ourense Province (Spain), Bad Ems (Germany), Halkidiki Tourism Organization (Greece) also featured in the programme.

Approximately 40 people were present in person and there were nearly 400 views on facebook

The event was well-covered in the local news.
