Multimedia exhibition "The First Lady of Serbian Literature"

Summary

The multimedia exhibition was dedicated to Isidora Sekulić, one of the Serbian women writers included in the WWR and was prepared by the Novi Sad City Library, a WWR member.

It presented the life and work of the writer and it featured a VR reconstruction of her room as well as some of her personal items (chair, type-writer, manuscripts...). The visitors at the inauguration could also listen to an audio recording of her. It was accompanied by a custom-made video. The exhibition was placed into a newly renovated 19th century hall which serves as one of the "cultural stations" in the programme of Novi Sad – European Capital of Culture 2022. Thus, the exhibition was also part of the programme of the European Capital of Culture. A special catalogue and promotional materials (bookmarks) were prepared at this occasion.

The exhibition was open for general public but a special emphasis was given on young visitors. The organizers have agreed with local high schools that the students will visit the exhibition as part of their curriculum.

A special tour was prepared for the members of the WWR network: they visited the author's birthplace, a village of Mošorin close to Novi Sad as well as her memorial room in the Belgrade University Library and Zemun, the town where she lived and wrote about.

Main objectives

Presenting and promoting the life and work of Serbian writer Isidora Sekulić, especially to youth.

- Enhancement of memory, history and European heritage
- Cultural and educational exchanges for young Europeans
- Contemporary cultural and artistic practice
- Cultural tourism and sustainable cultural development
