

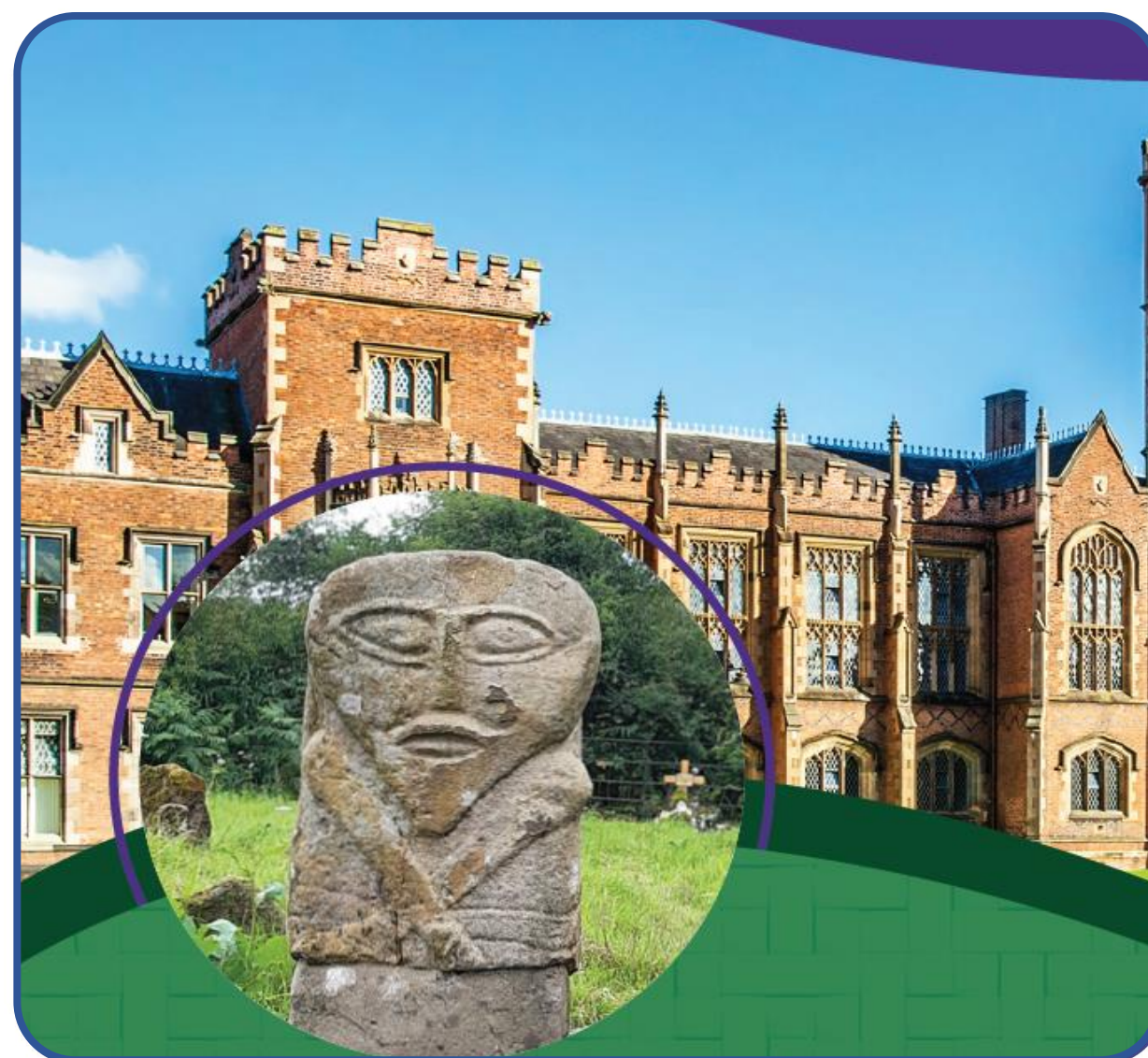

Routed Archaeology IV: On the path of synergy

Summary

The 23rd Annual Meeting of the European Association of Archaeologists included the session "ROUTED ARCHAEOLOGY IV: ON THE PATH OF SYNERGY," co-organized by the IADR. This session focused on cultural heritage, sustainable cultural tourism, and cultural routes in archaeology. Archaeology faces the dual pressures of increased specialization and the need to engage more with society, balancing the demands for public funding and developing collaboration with local communities, authorities, NGOs, and the tourism sector. The session aimed to highlight the benefits of a participative approach to governance in archaeological heritage, emphasizing cultural routes as a means to align diverse stakeholder objectives. It also invited discussions on key documents shaping archaeological heritage management, such as the Faro Convention and the new ICOMOS International Cultural Heritage Tourism Charter.
