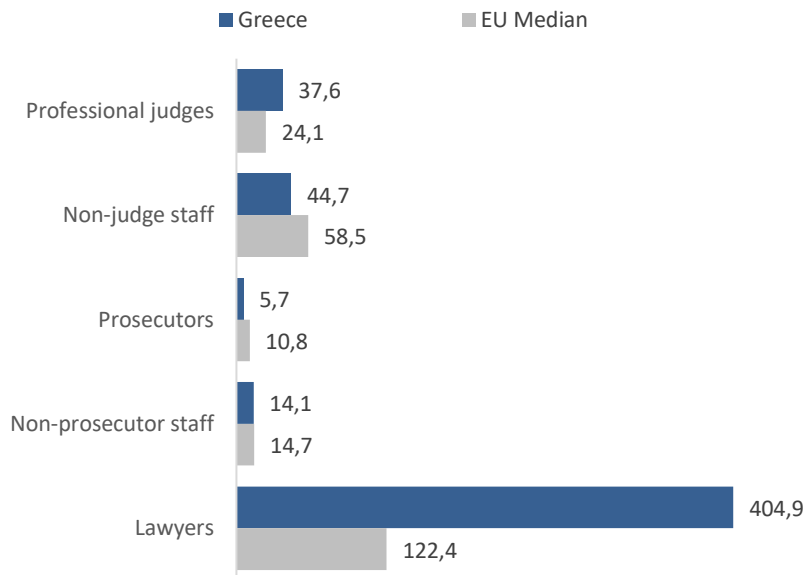

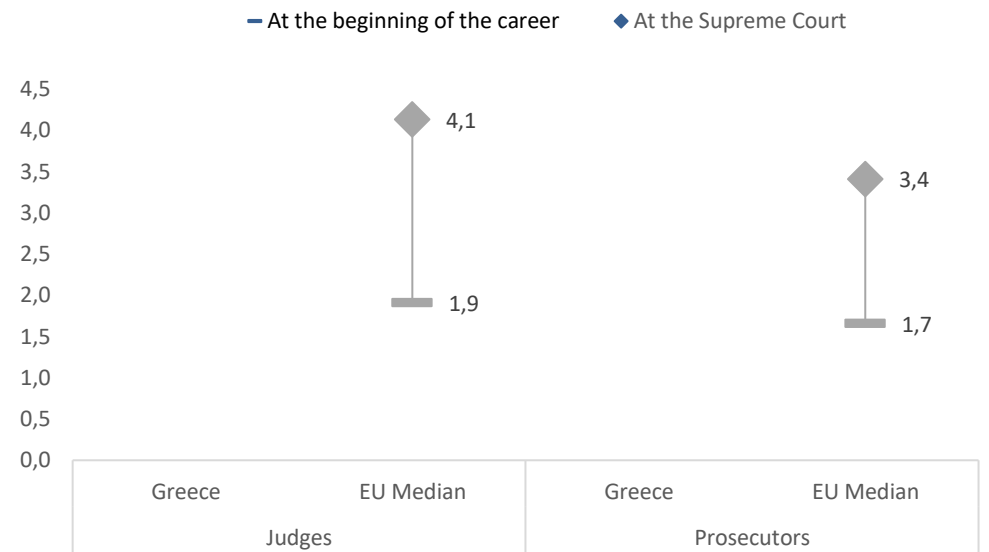

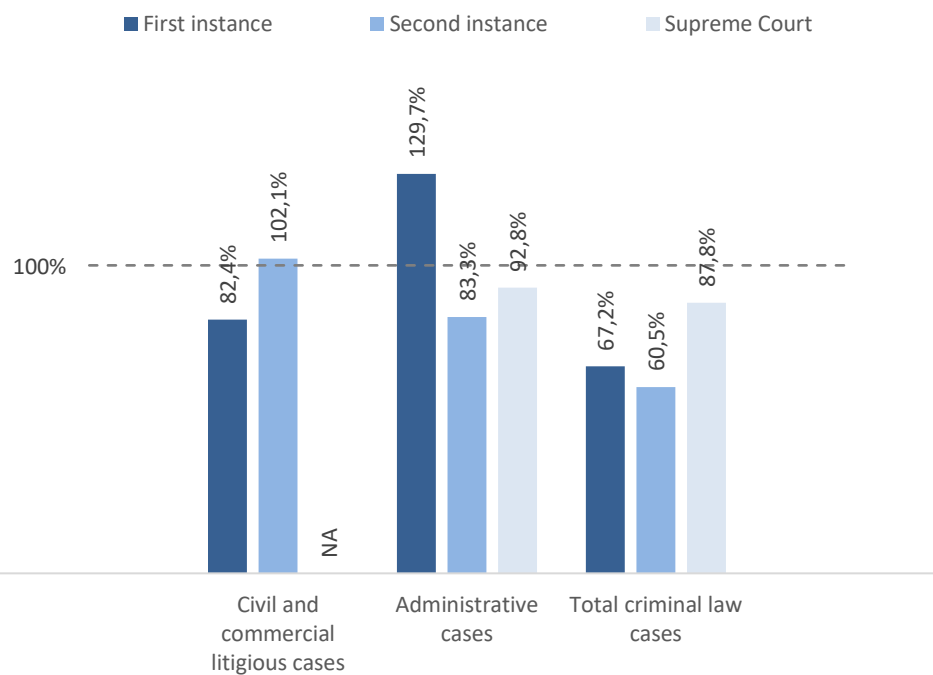


Gross salaries of judges and prosecutors vs average annual salary in 2021

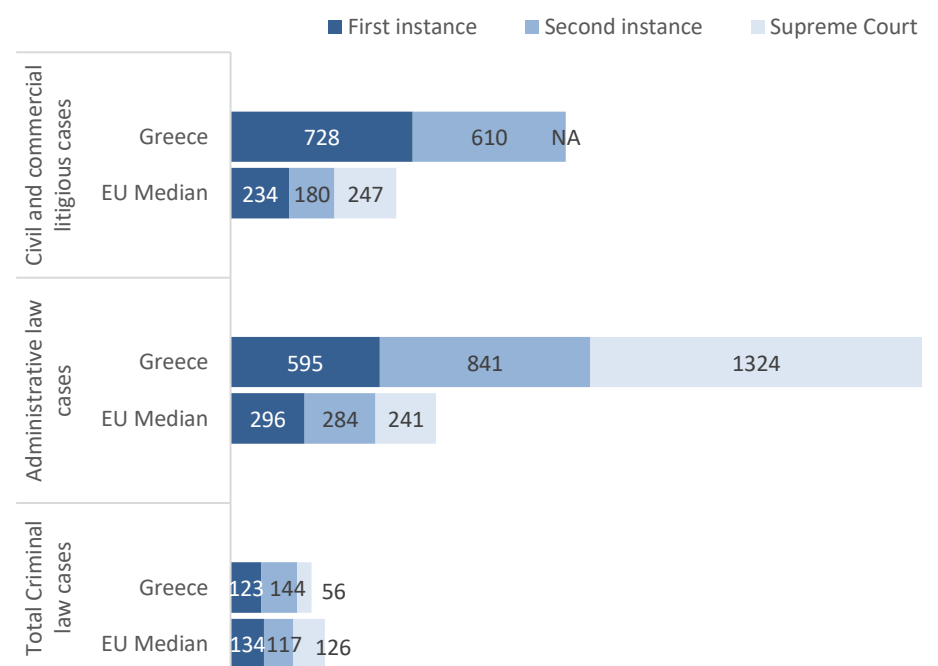

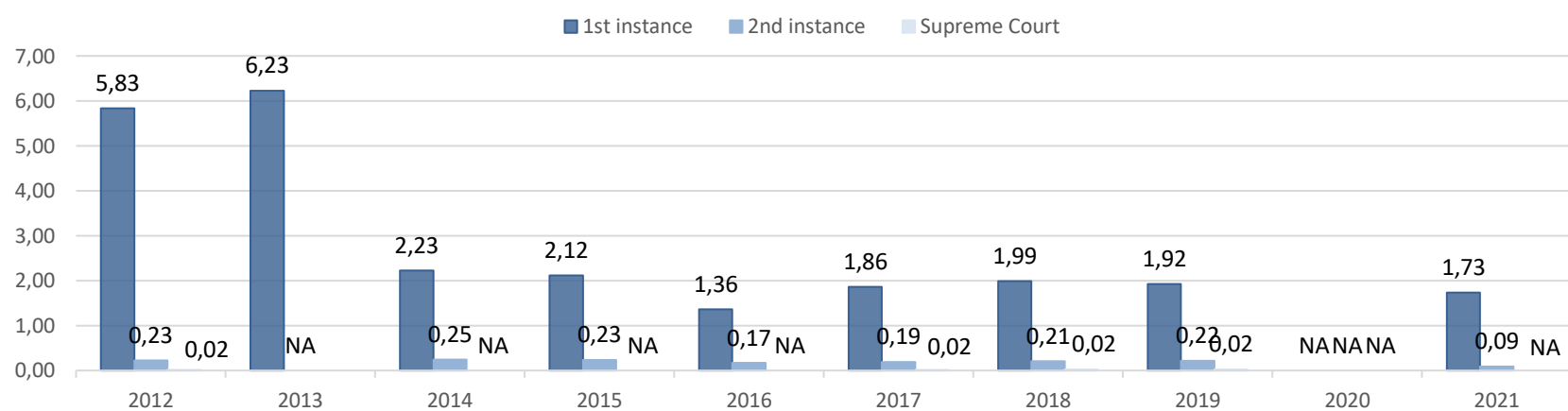


Disposition Time by instance and by matter in 2021 (days)

1. Judicial organisation in Greece (2021 data)

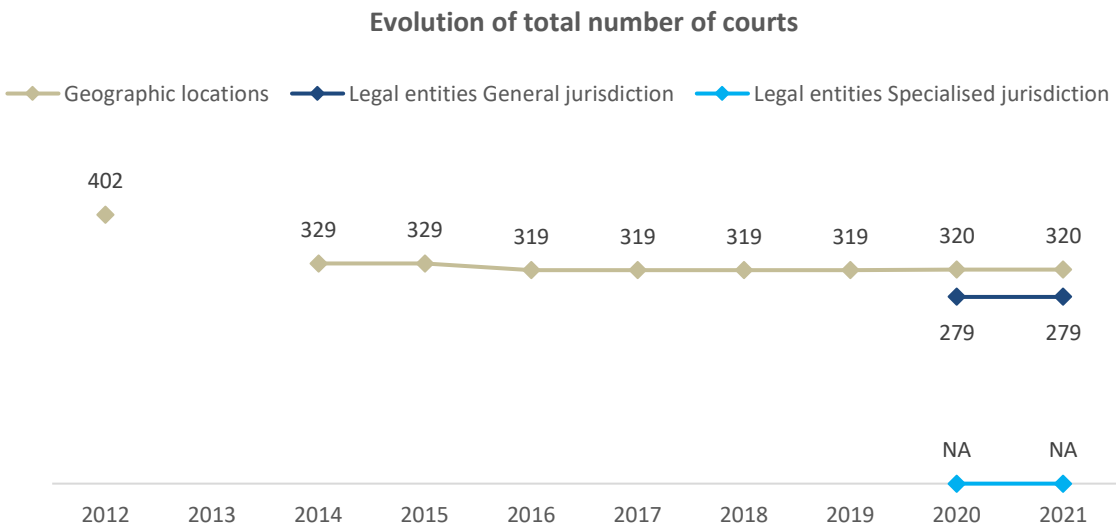
In Greece, the total number of courts of general jurisdiction (legal entities) is 279. There are 259 first instance courts of general jurisdiction (196 Local and District Criminal Courts and 63 Courts of First Instance). There are 19 second instance courts of general jurisdiction and the Supreme Court as the highest court of general jurisdiction (Areios Pagos).

The accurate number of first instance specialized courts encompassing administrative courts, military courts and other courts is not available. However, it is reported that administrative courts include 30 first instance courts, 9 second instance courts and 1 Supreme Court (the Council of State) that is considered as one of the three supreme courts in Greece. The higher instance other specialized court is the Court of Auditors that is also considered as one of three supreme courts in Greece.

There are in total 320 courts as geographic locations.

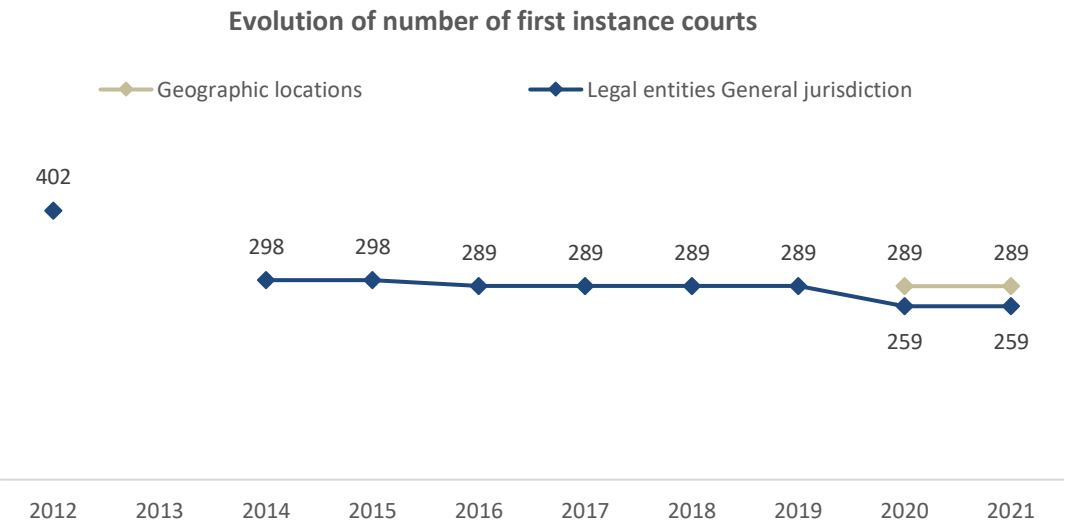

In Greece, there are no special courts for the different fields of law described above, besides those already mentioned. The Greek Constitution is reluctant to provide special courts in the Greek legal system. Instead, within the courts of first instance and courts of appeal of large cities, there are special chambers, where the task of adjudicating in special categories of law (e.g. family law, commercial law, etc.) is assigned. Judges entrusted with such duties have usually the relevant specific studies.

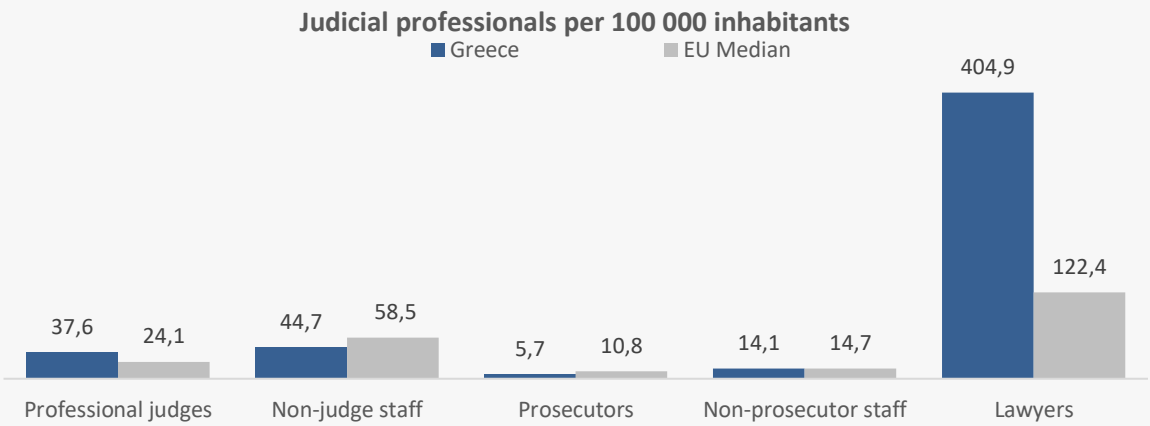
As far as other special courts are concerned, special provisions regulate the operation of military, navy and air force courts. It is to clarify that the military, navy and air force courts are under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of National Defence, therefore there is no further information.

Administrative courts include: in the first instance 30, in the second instance 9 and 1 Supreme Court (the Council of State).

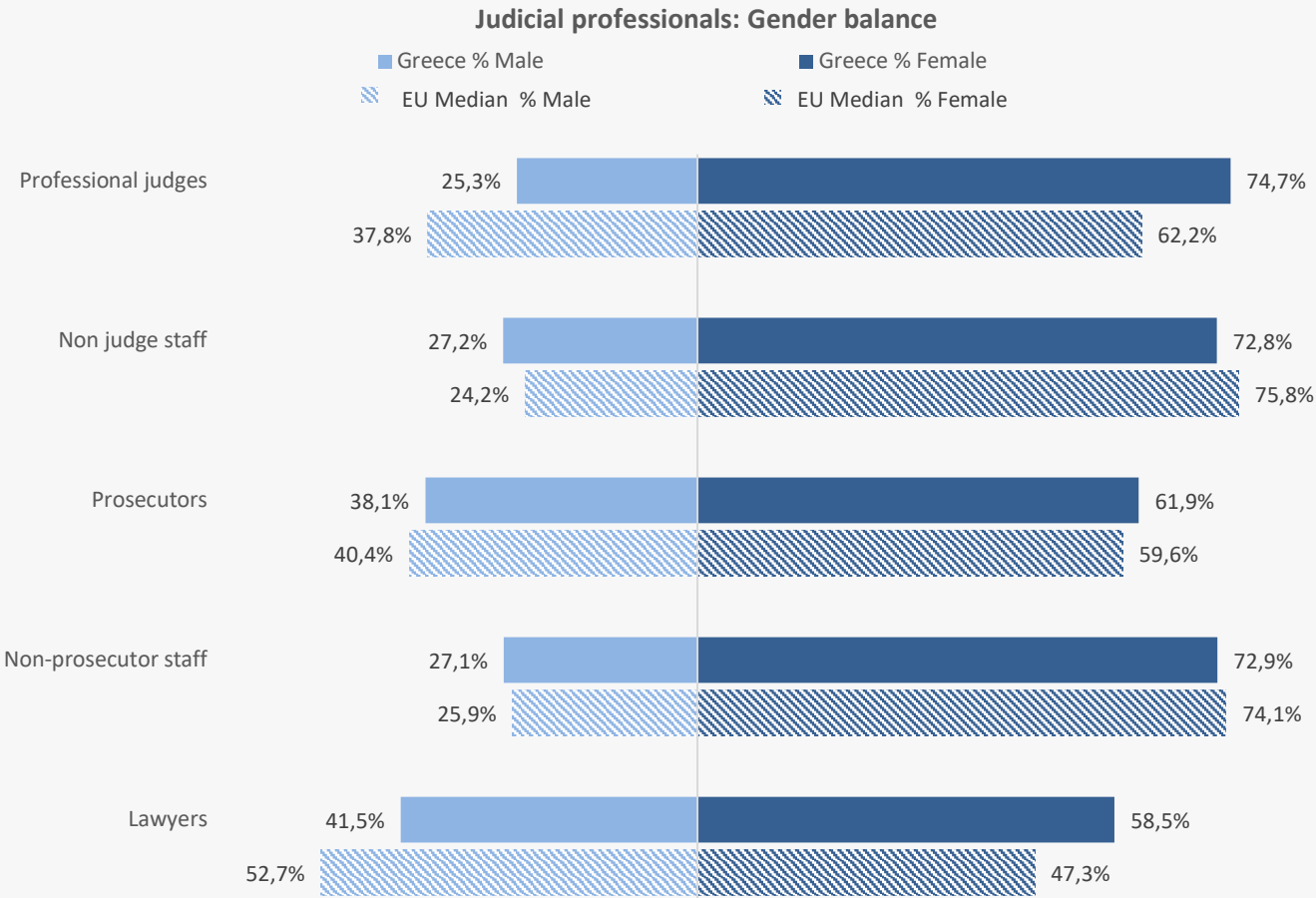

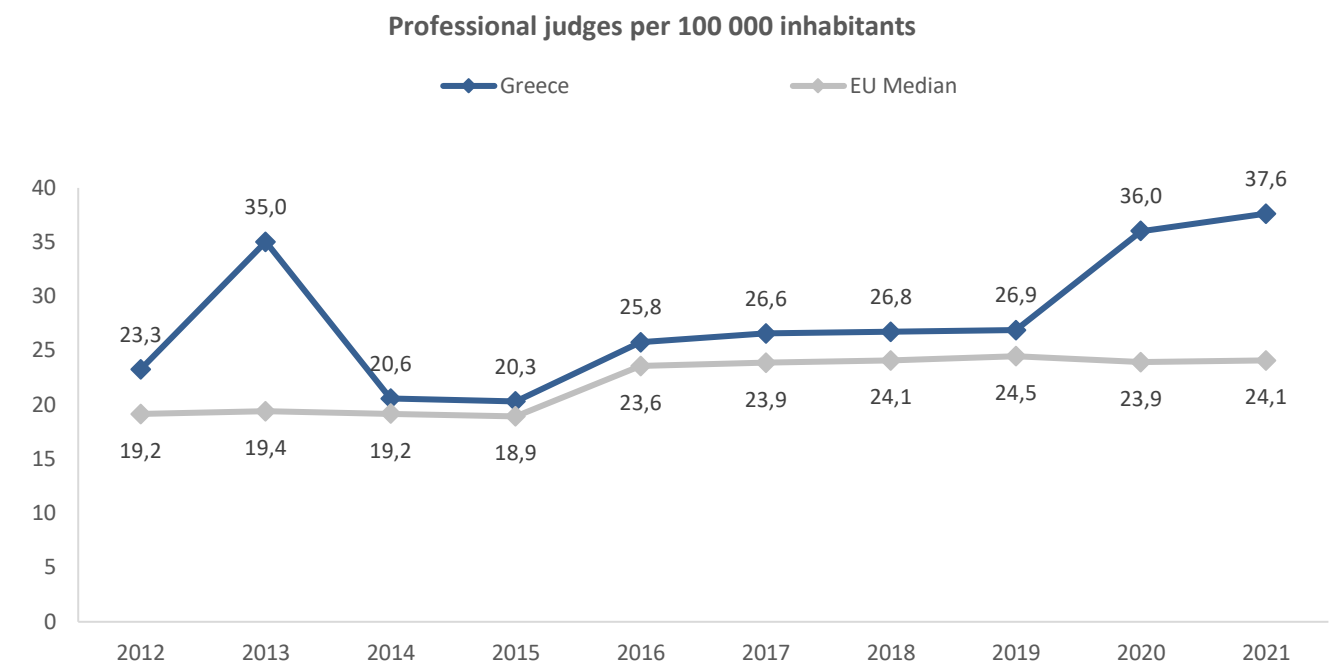

According to 2021 data, the total number of professional judges sitting in courts (all instances) in Greece is 4 018, which is 4,1% more than in the previous cycle.

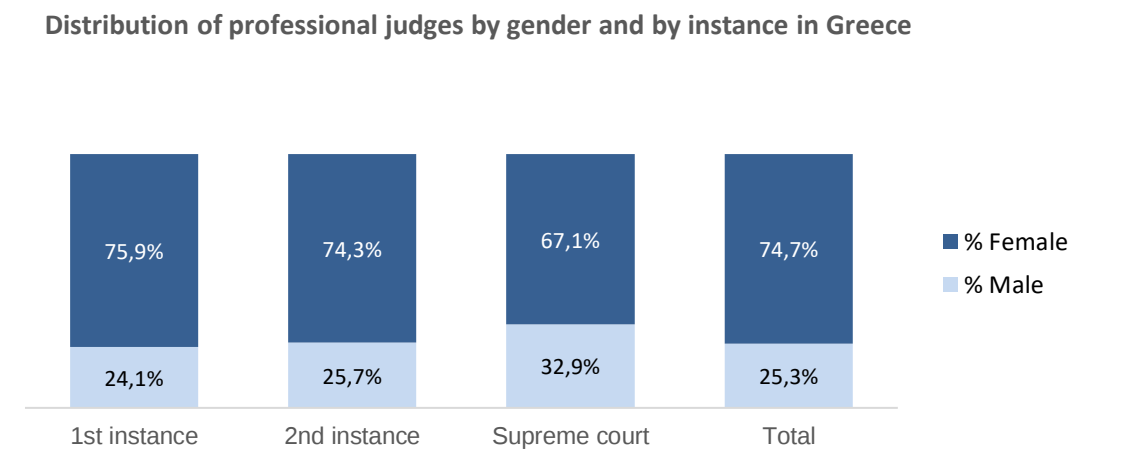
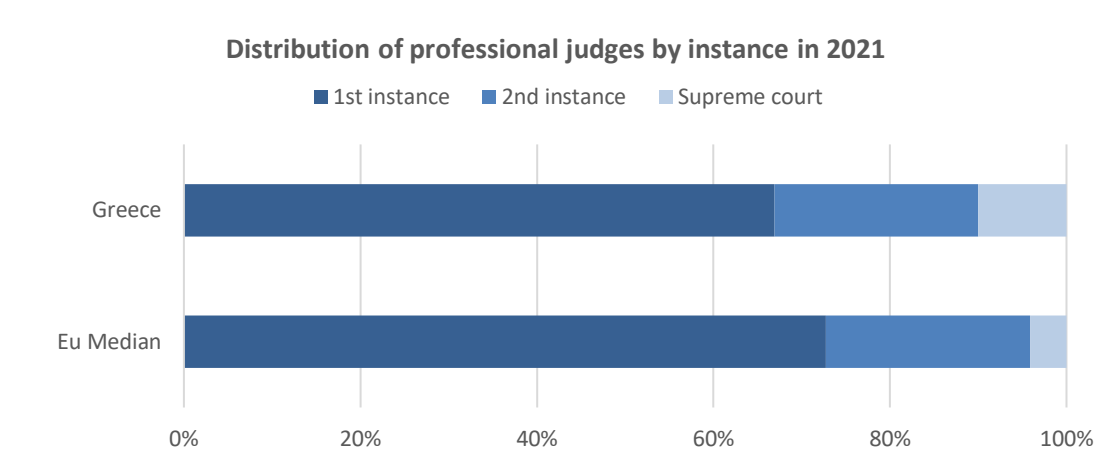
More precisely, in Greece, there are 37,63 professional judges per 100 000 inhabitants (this figure is well above the EU median of 24,11 judges per 100 000 inhabitants) and about 1,19 non-judge staff per judge.

There has been an increase compared with previous cycle when this ratio was at 1,09 non-judge staff per judge.

The increase in the number of Supreme court professional judges is explained by the fact that, in 2021, judges of the Court of auditors, who are all supreme, have been included for the first time.

In this cycle, the total number of Female professional judges (all instances) is 3 001, which represents 74,7% of the total number of judges.

The total number of judges is distributed among the different judicial instances in the following way: 2 690 are sitting in first instance courts (of which 2 043 are Female); 927 are sitting in second instance courts (of which 689 are Female) and 401 are sitting in Supreme Court (of which 269 are Female).

Compared with the EU distribution of professional judges per instance, Greece follows similar trends, but with slightly less judges in the first instance courts and a bit more judges in the Supreme court's level.

As regards the methodology of presentation of data in respect of the number of judges, it should be noticed that the methodology of replying changed which caused differences in numbers compared to the previous years.

As regards the distribution Male/Female, it has to be specified that in Greece, there is a high percentage of female judges in all instances (75,9 % in first instance courts, 74,3% in second instance courts and 67,1% in Supreme courts).

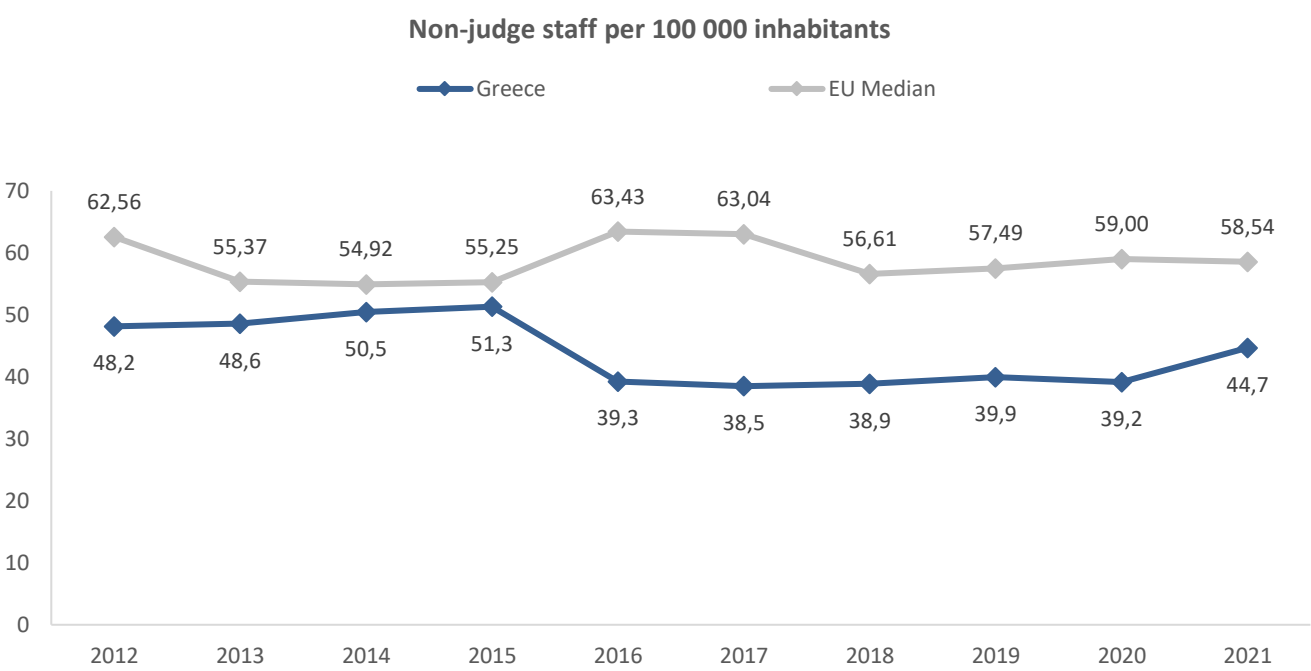

In 2021, Greece has 4 774 non-judge staff (of which 3 475 are Female). The total number of non-judge staff in comparison with the previous cycle reveals an increase of 13,7%.

In 2021, the number of non-judge staff per 100 000 inhabitants has increased (from 39,2 in 2020 to 44,7 in 2021).

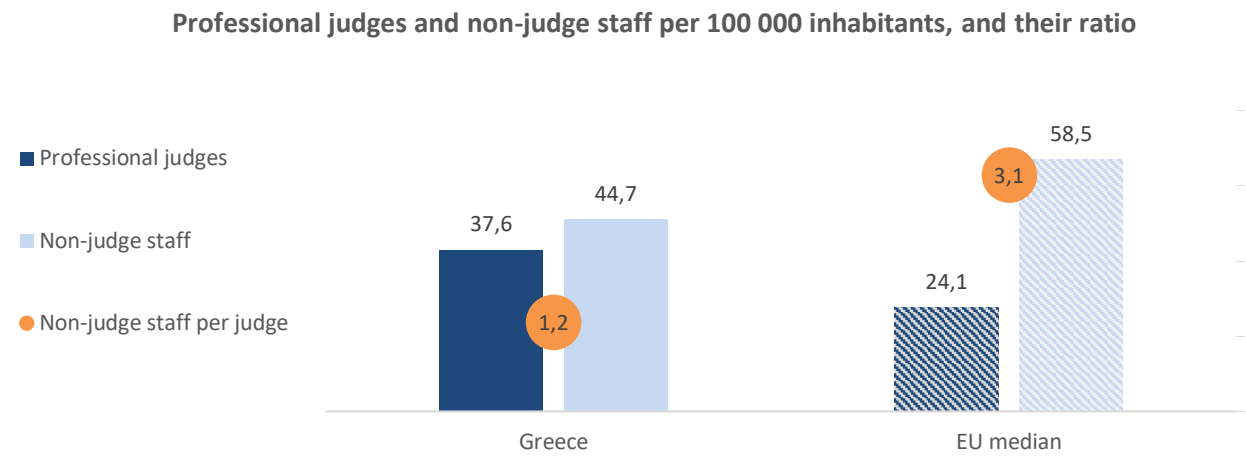

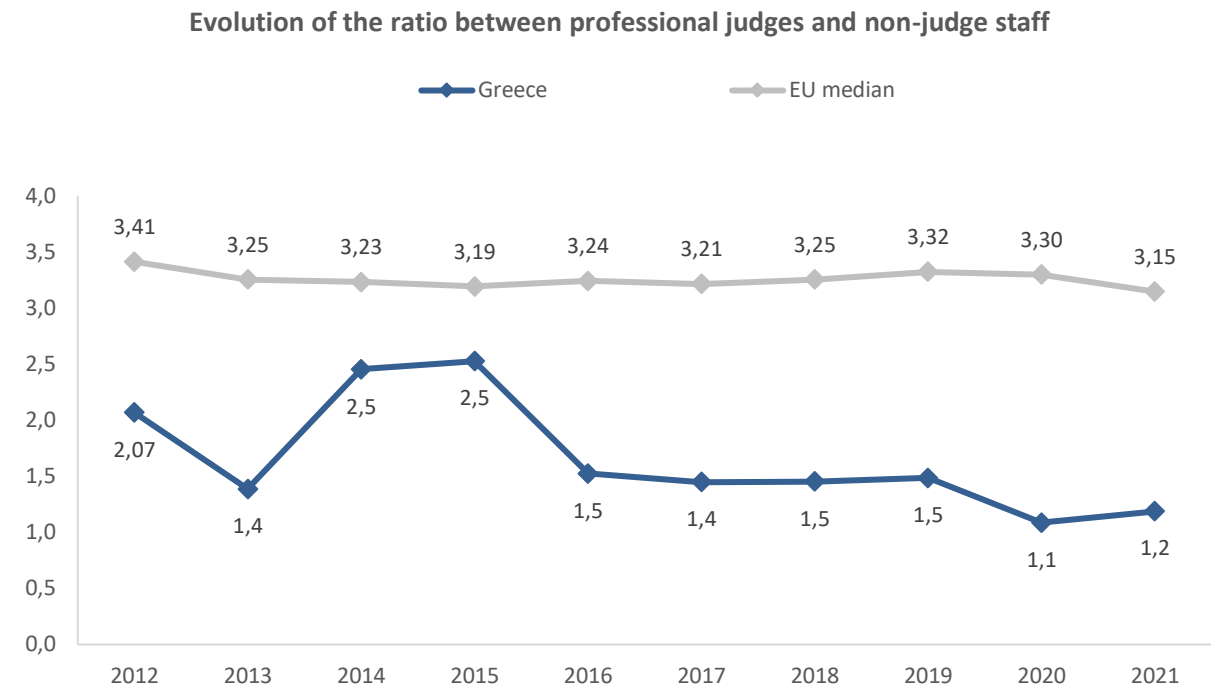

Evolution of the ratio between professional judges and non-judge staff

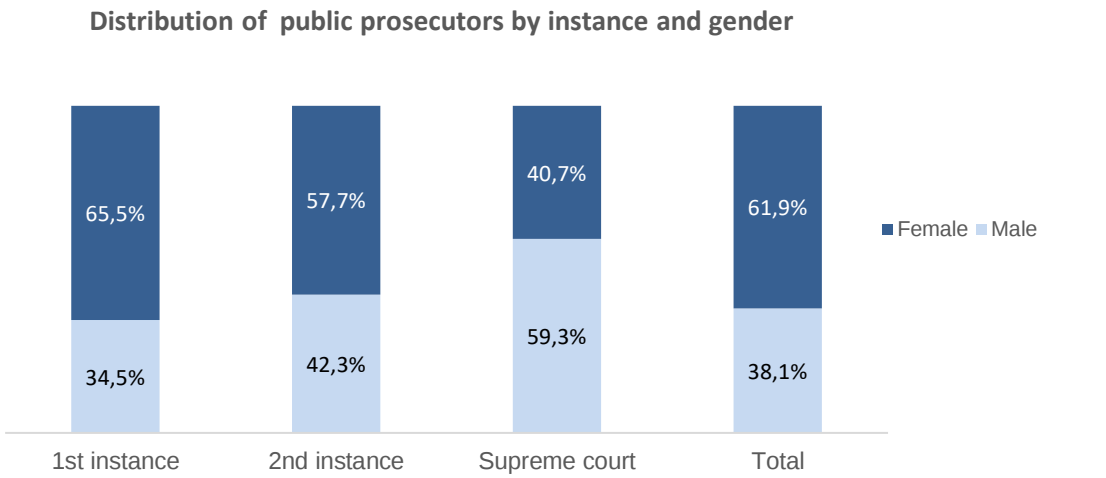
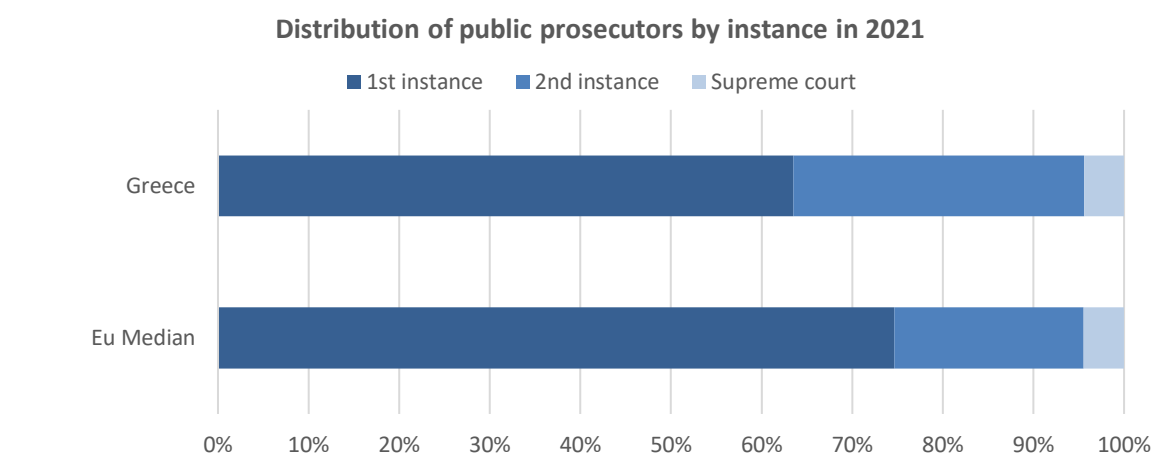

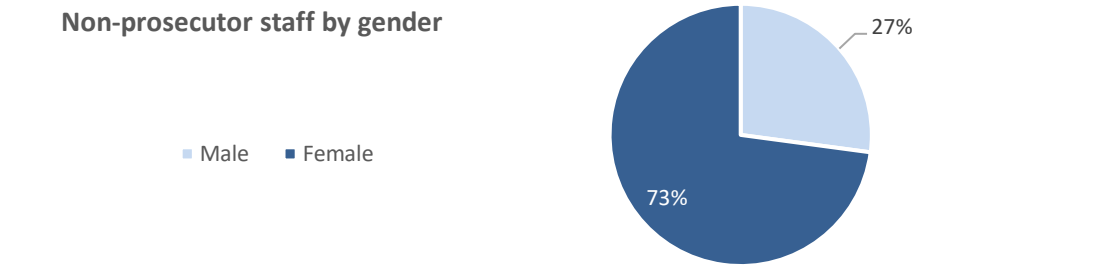
In this cycle, the total number of Female prosecutors (all instances) is 378, which represents 61,9% of the total number of prosecutors.

The total number of prosecutors is distributed among the different judicial instances in the following way: 388 in first instance (of which 254 are Female); 196 are in second instance (of which 113 are Female) and 27 in final instance (of which 11 are Female).

As regards the distribution Male/Female, it has to be specified that in Greece, there is an important percentage of female prosecutors in first instance (65,5 %), second instance (57,7%) and per total (61,9%). There is however no majority of female prosecutors at Supreme court level (40,7%).

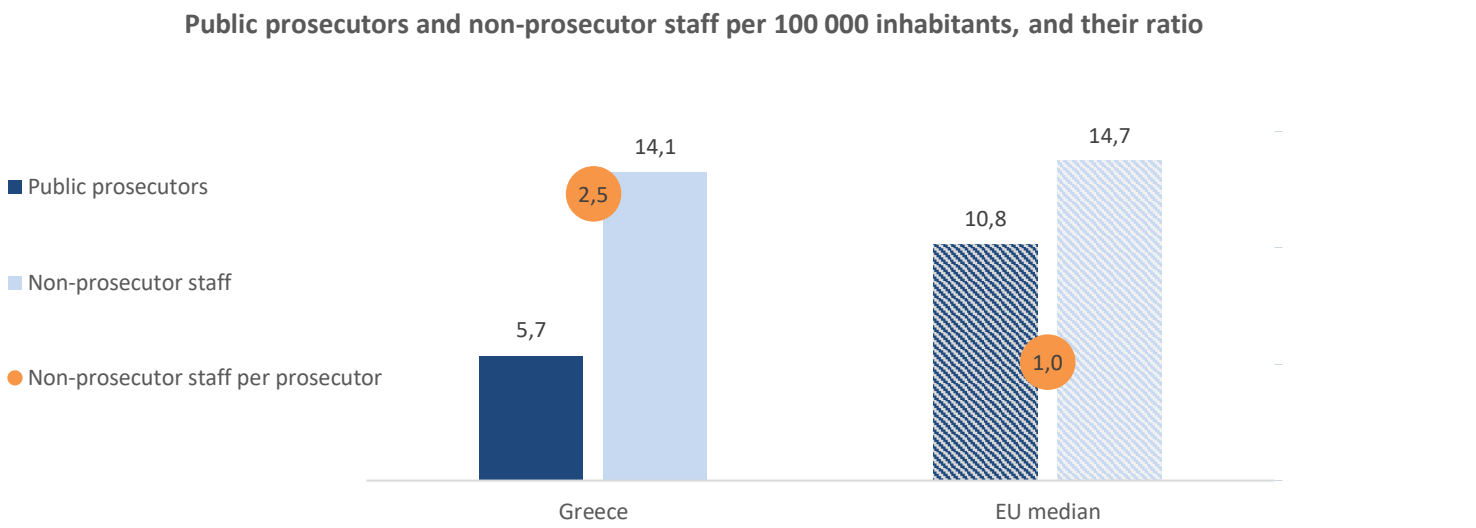

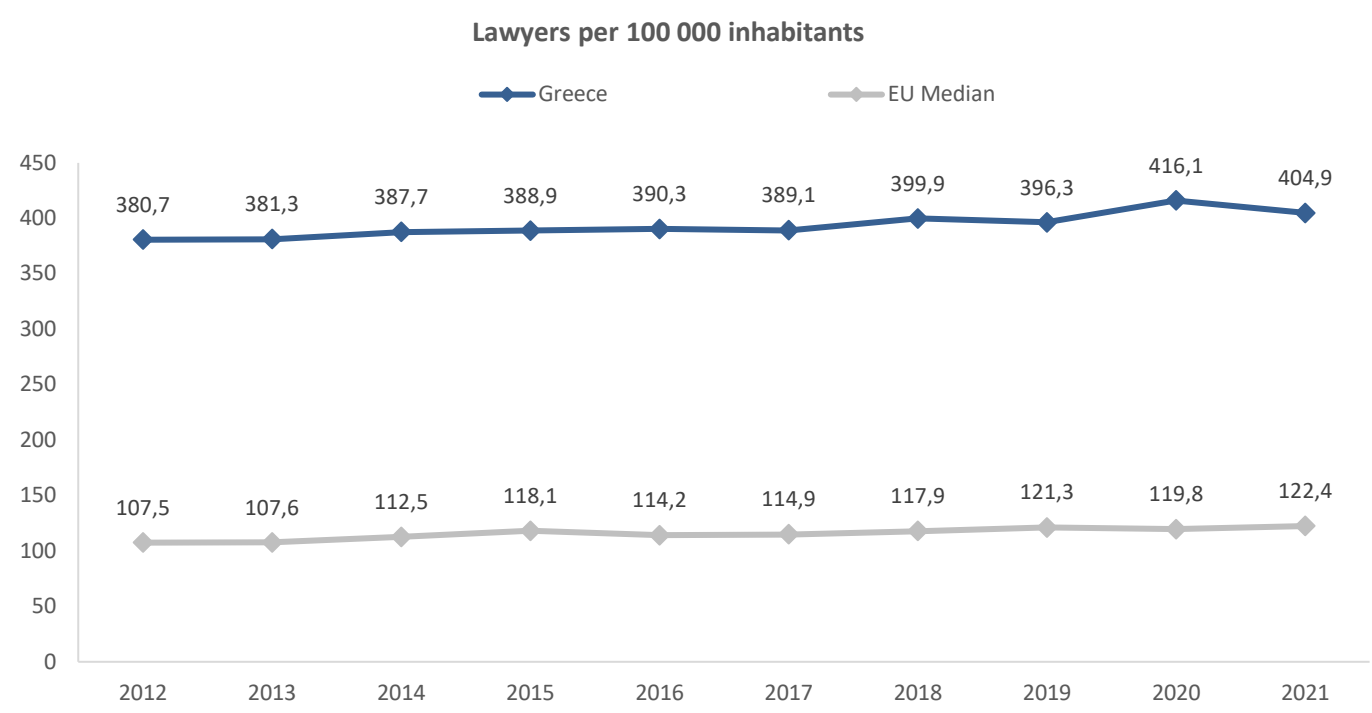


Ratio between non-prosecutor staff and public prosecutors

According to 2021 data, the absolute gross salary of a judge at the beginning of his/her career in Greece of 31 710€ is considerably below when compared to the EU median of 52 534€.

The ratio with the annual average salary of the country cannot be calculated.

3. Legal aid and court fees in Greece (2021 data)

In Greece, legal aid is available for :

Low-income citizens are entitled to the provision of free legal assistance, that is, the granting of a lawyer, bailiff or notary, in cases of criminal, civil and commercial law of any degree. These include divorce, alimony, custody and communication, insult, paternity recognition, etc.

Greek citizens, EU citizens, as well as third-country citizens or stateless persons are entitled to legal aid if they have a legal residence or usual residence in Greece. Low-income citizens, beneficiaries of legal aid, are those whose annual family income does not exceed two-thirds of the minimum annual individual earnings provided for by the National General Collective Labour Agreement.

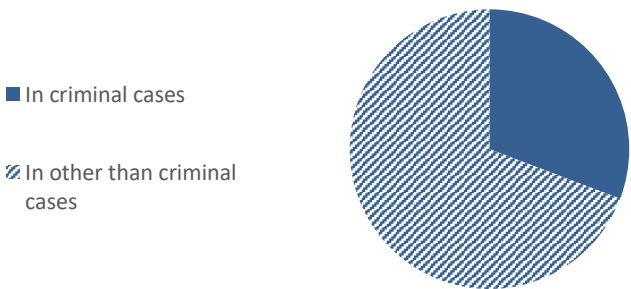
Legal Aid is provided at the request of the applicant, in compliance with the law 3226/2004 as amended and completed by law 4274/20. Furthermore, if an expert's opinion is considered by the court to be necessary, then the relevant costs are covered by the State.

With regard to administrative courts, there is no such legislative provision, while in civil and commercial cases legal aid is granted for expert fees.

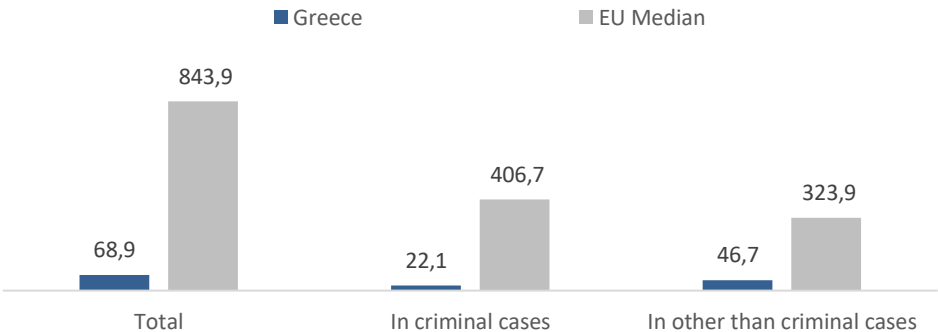

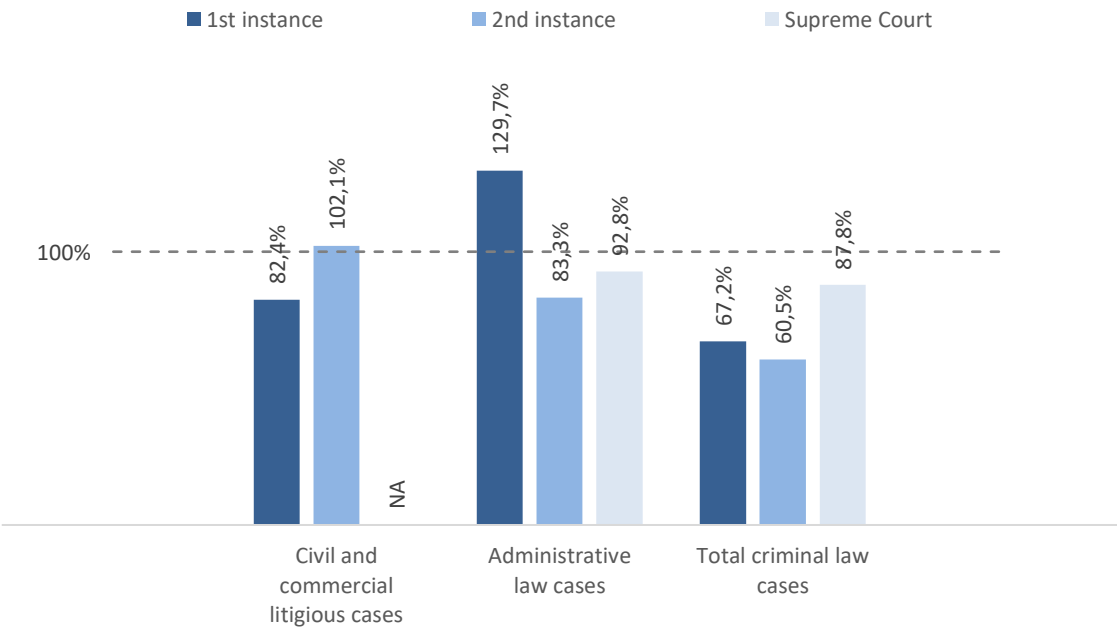
The Clearance Rate shows the capacity of a judicial system to deal with the incoming cases. A Clearance Rate of 100% and higher does not generate backlog.

The Disposition Time determines the estimated number of days necessary for a pending case to be solved in a court.

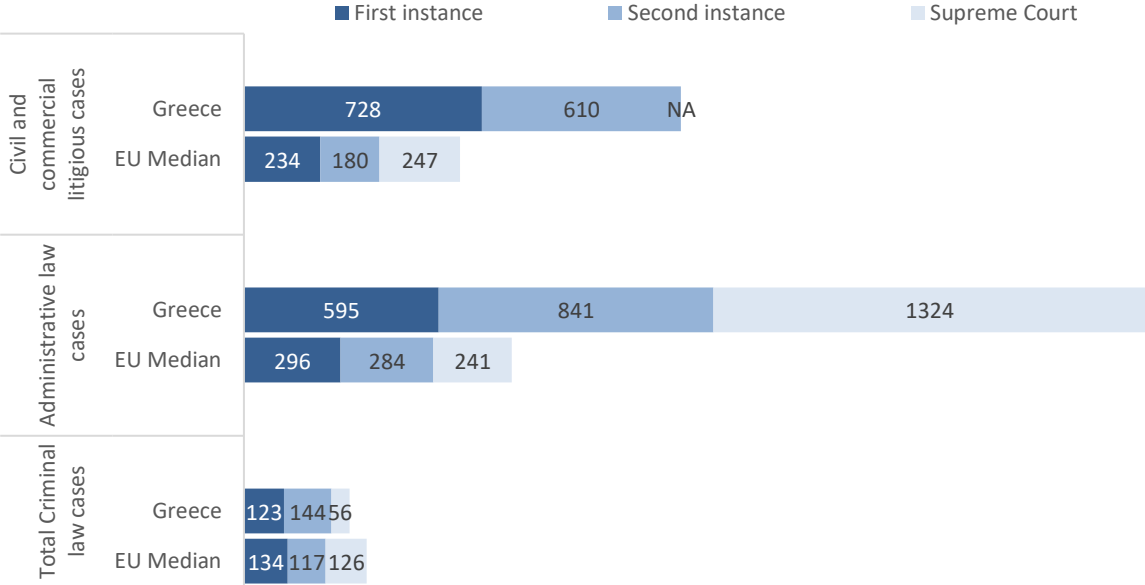

At the outset, it should be noticed that data on third instance civil cases are not available for the reference year.

Against the background of the available data, in 2021, criminal law cases appear to be overall the fastest in Greece, which is similar to the trend observed in the EU for the reference year. At the same time, administrative law cases are overall the longest in Greece, as it appears also in the EU, but significantly above the EU median. The total length of proceedings in Greece is above EU median, except for criminal law cases, where it is slightly below.

At first instance, the Clearance Rate indicator is satisfactory for administrative law cases, with a Clearance Rate above the 100% threshold, whereas for civil litigious and criminal law cases, the Clearance Rate is below the 100% threshold. The Disposition Time is above the EU median for both civil litigious and administrative law cases.

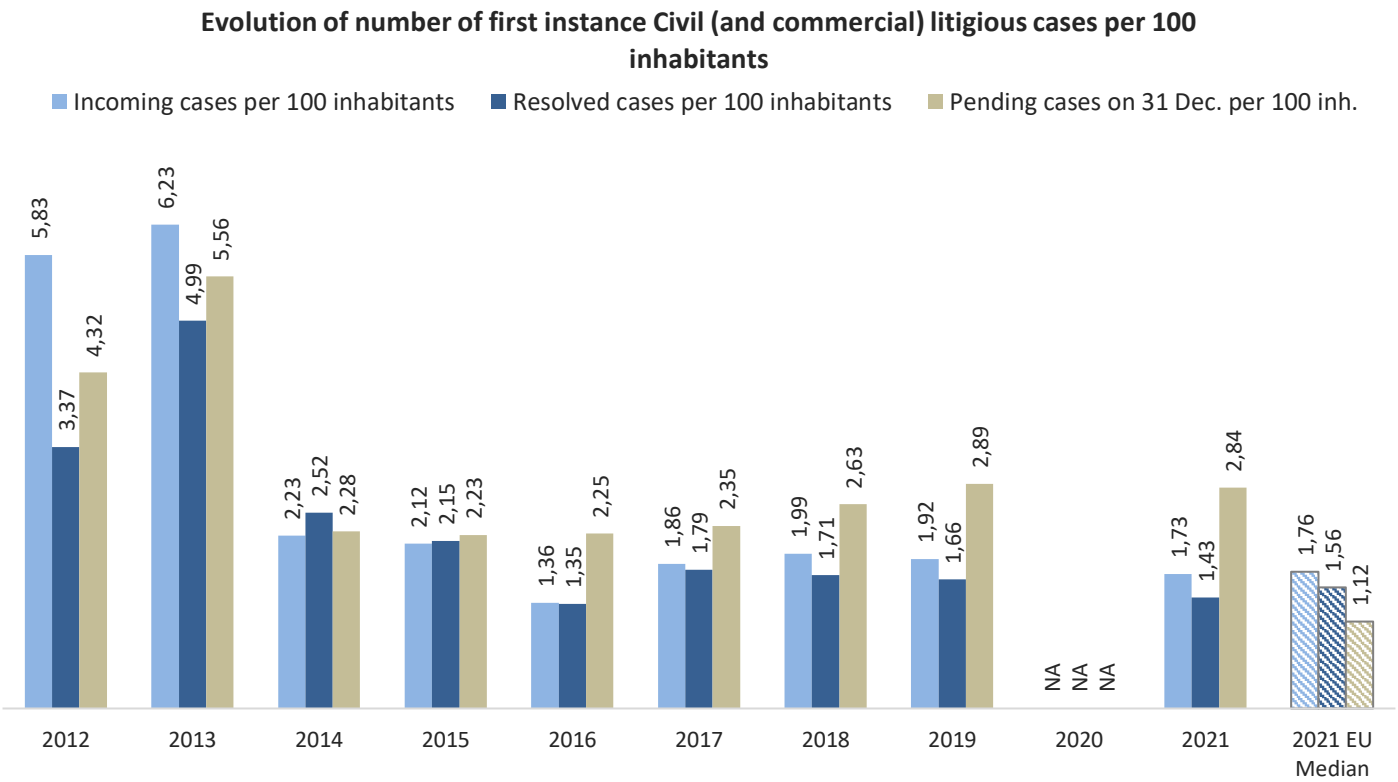
In the second instance, courts seem to be the most efficient in civil litigious cases, with a Clearance Rate above the 100% threshold. The Disposition Time remains however significantly above the EU median for all types of cases.

At third instance, courts seem to face some difficulties in dealing with cases, where the Clearance Rate is somewhat below the 100% threshold. The Disposition Time remains above the EU median for administrative law cases, while it is considerably below the EU median in criminal matters.

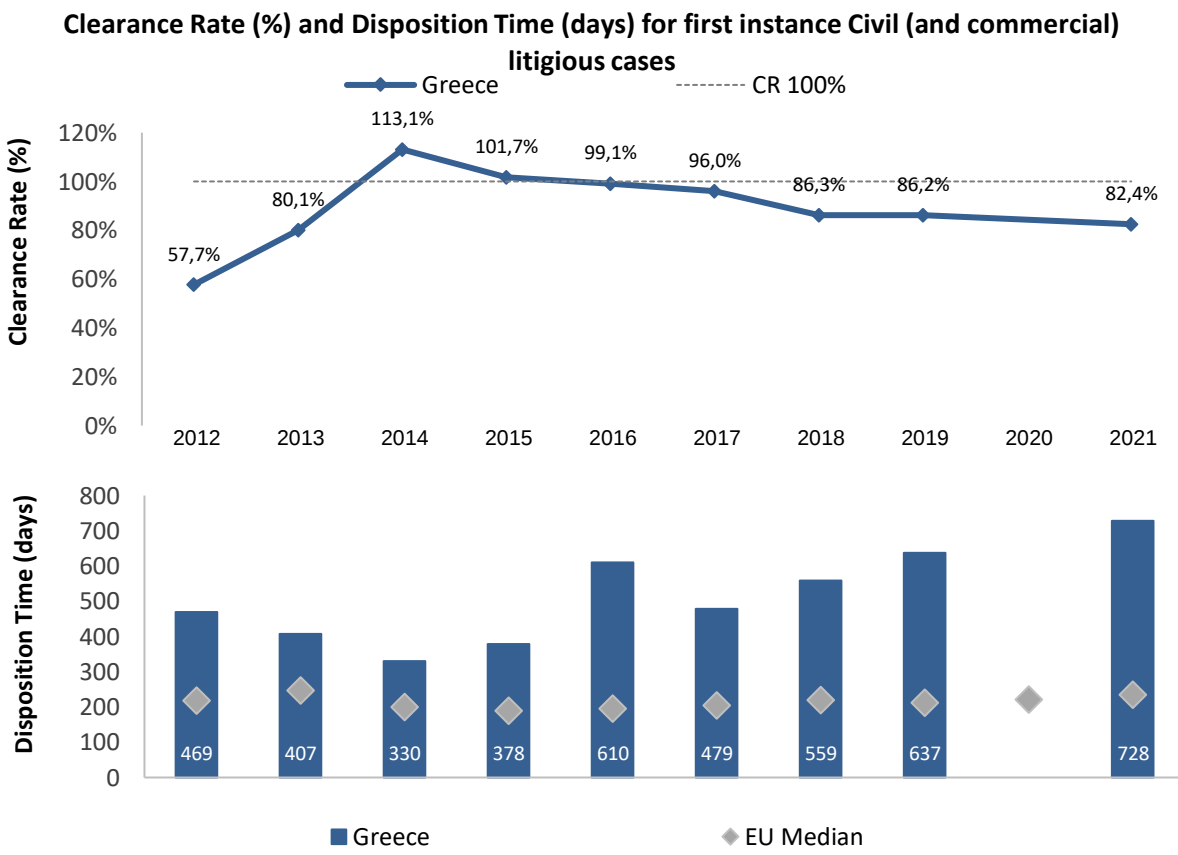

The variation of the Clearance rate between 2020 and 2021 cannot be calculated, as data were not available in the previous cycle.

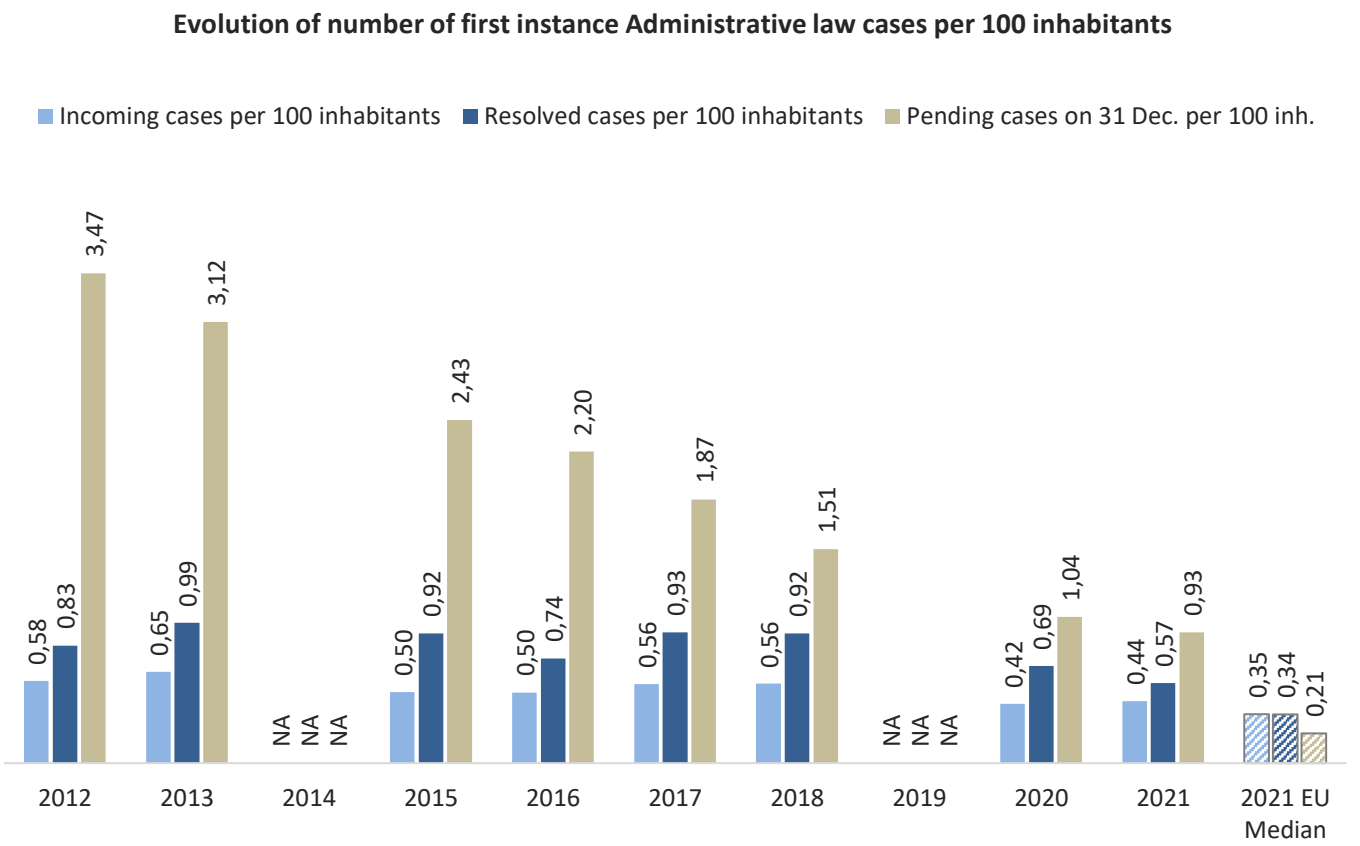

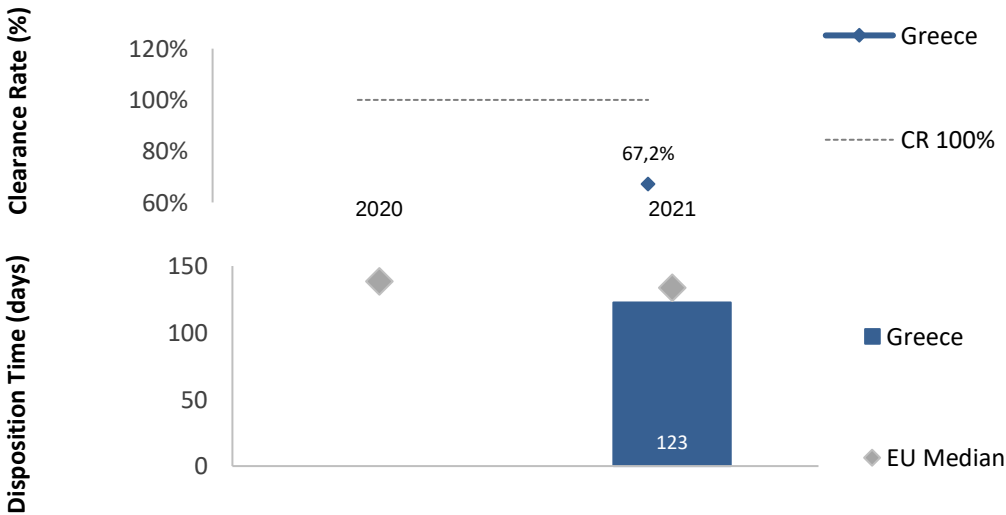

8. Systems for measuring and evaluating the performance of courts and public prosecution services in Greece (2021 data)

In Greece, quality standards are determined for the judicial system at national level (e.g. quality systems for the judiciary and/or judicial quality policies), by the Code of Organization of Courts and Status of Judicial Officers (Law 1756/1988). Personnel within the courts and the public prosecution services is entrusted with implementation of these national level quality standards.

Most of the measures taken recently in Greece aim at speeding up administrative justice. However, the law provides a set of quality criteria that must be taken into account when inspectors check the performance of each judge.

According to Law 1756/1988 (art. 85), supreme judges appointed as inspectors for one year's term, draft every year general reports on the operation of each court and prosecutor's office in their district and recommend the necessary measures for the proper functioning of the service. Regarding administrative courts, this task is fulfilled by the General Commission of the State for ordinary administrative courts.

In Greece, there is a system to regularly evaluate the court performance based primarily on defined indicators and the frequency of the reporting is annual.
