What is the European Day on the Protection of Children against Sexual Exploitation and Sexual Abuse?

- ▶ On the European Day everyone should learn about sexual violence against children, how to prevent it, how to stay safe and how to get help. Usually adults organise events, conferences and trainings on this day.
- ▶ This year is different because adults will be there to support YOU to organise your own event!
- ▶ The European Day is celebrated on **18 November**.

Ok, but what is the European Day really about?

- ▶ It's about lots of different topics, for example sexuality education, dangers in the online world, bullying with private pictures, protection from sexual violence in sport, at school, in the family...
- ▶ You can choose any related topic you are interested in!

So what can I do on the European Day?

- ▶ Do something different: organise a thematic day, a talk, a lesson, an exhibition, a social event (online – offline) or a flashmob. You can address your friends, teachers, parents or decision-makers! You can do anything you want as long as it raises awareness on sexual violence against children.
