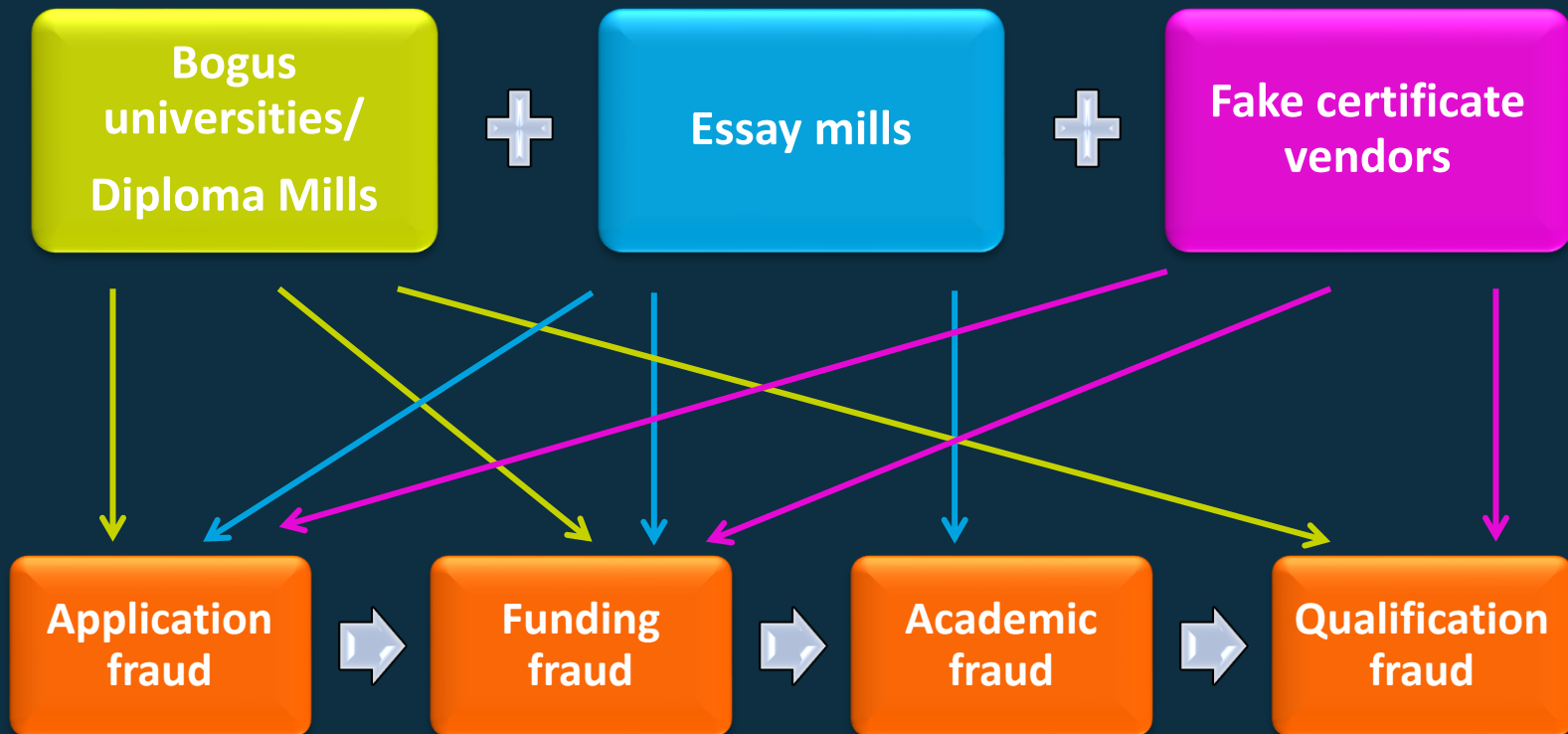

Lies and statistics

Data gathered by the UK's Office for National Statistics reveal that, in the last three years, of **138,000** HR managers and directors in the UK **14%** have dealt with at least five instances of employees not holding the certifications they claimed – *the equivalent of about 100,000 job applicants*. That number could be even higher if more employers made checks.

40% of companies spent more than £10,000 in the last three years rehiring staff after employing someone who wasn't properly qualified.





Chris Wallace is the William Tyler Professor of Economics and Head of Department. Before arriving in Leicester in 2011, he was the Fellow and Tutor in Economics at Trinity College, Oxford, and a Lecturer, and latterly Professor of Economic Theory, at the University of Oxford between 2000 and 2011. Before this he was an undergraduate and graduate at the London School of Economics; he completed his doctorate in 1999 at Nuffield College, Oxford, where he continued to work as an Open Prize Research Fellow between 1998 and 2000. His research is in the area of game theory: in particular his work focuses on issues of equilibrium selection and the use and value of information in games. He has published papers in journals such as the *Review of Economic Studies*, the *Economic Journal*, the *Journal of Economic Theory*, and the *Journal of Monetary Economics*. He acted as business manager and company secretary for the *Review of Economic Studies* from 2004 to 2012, has been an associate editor of the *Economic Journal* since 2009, and has been Head of Department since 2014.

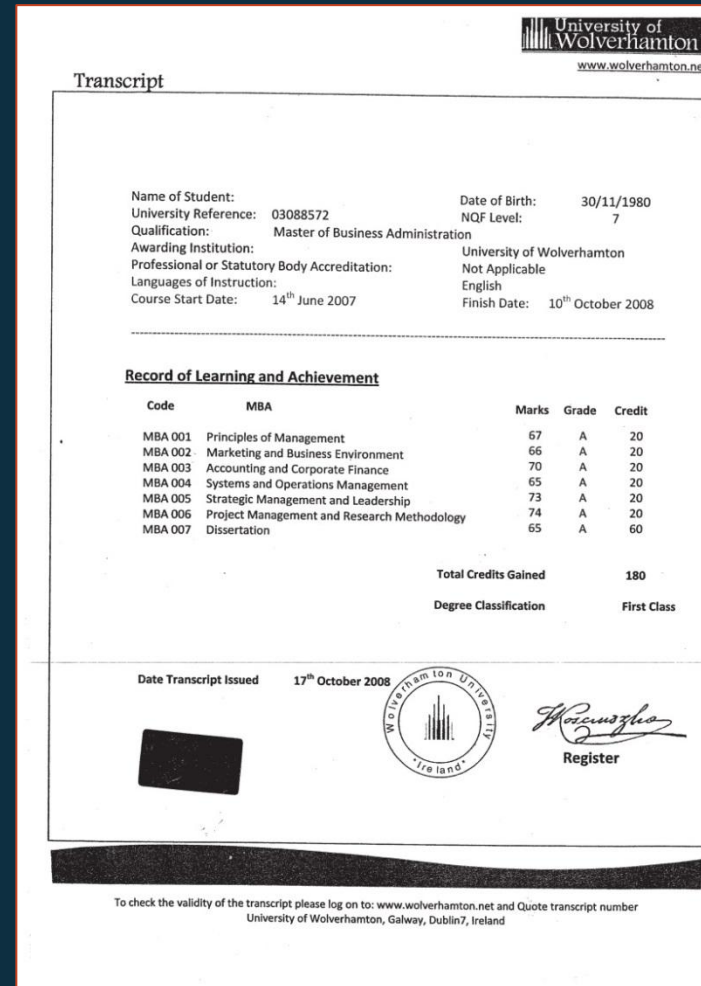

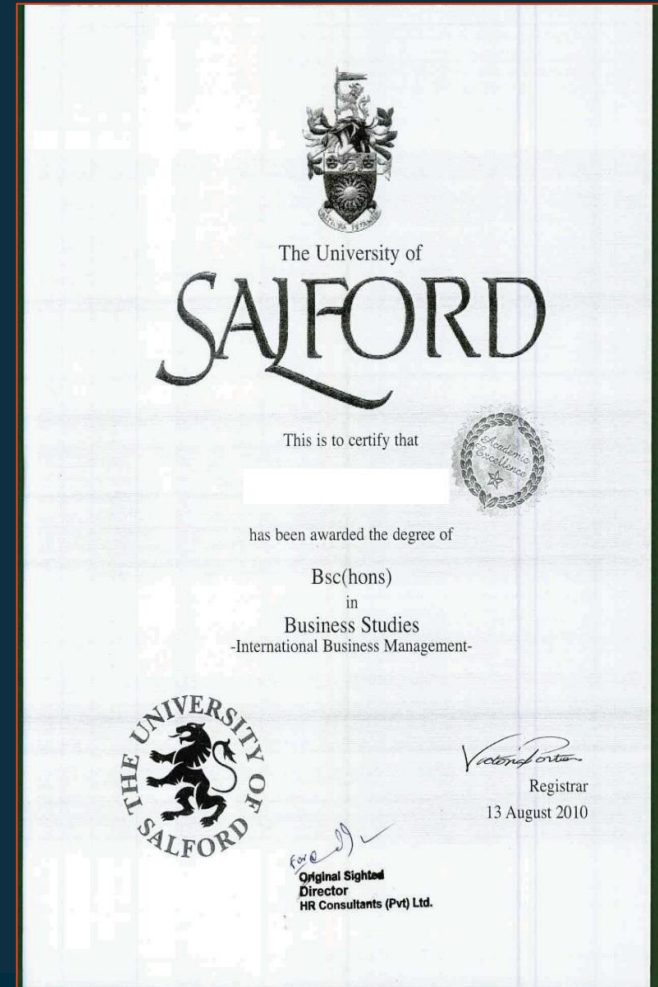
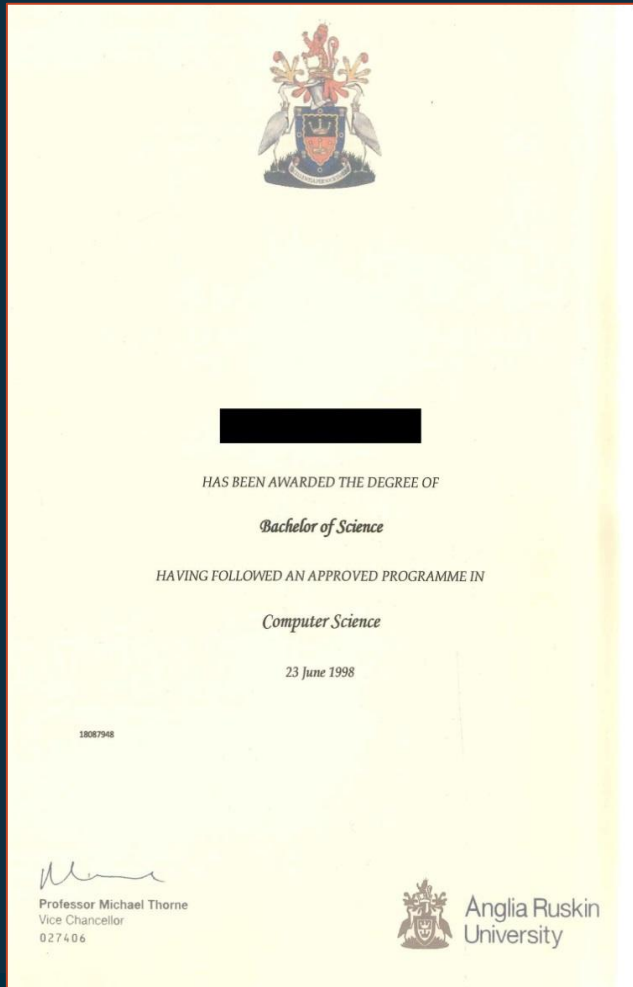

Graduation selfies leading to surge in first-class fake degrees

Jack Mahern The "selfie generation" of students who are about to graduate have been urged not to post pictures of themselves posing with their diplomas online to stem the trade in fake certificates. The number of fakes is estimated to have risen by up to 50 per cent in the past year. The most accurate, which are sold online for about £220 and can be used to deceive prospective employers, are considered such a threat that 20 universities, including Cardiff and Imperial College London, are offering digital certificates that cannot be faked. Graduates give companies a sign to access a copy and check the credentials. Jane Rowley, chief executive of the Higher Education Degree Database, said that "the selfie generation and the need to share these things online" was fueling the multimillion-pound trade because fraudsters could make detailed copies. She said that universities such as Oxford and Cambridge were among the main targets because of their prestige but often it was simply "the ones for which fingers have been able to get a good image of a certificate." She added: "We have bought fake certificates on eBay for as little as £15.50 with free delivery and Nextar print. The more expensive ones are typically sold for \$300." The university inadvertently provided high-resolution images of its certificates through its online shop. Although the website featured only a thumbnail picture, a more detailed one was accessible via Google's image search. Mr Rowley said: "If you want to set up a fake certificate website then Google is your friend. We'll be sending out advice to universities reminding them, please tell your students not to post pictures of their certificates. The fakes will all be desperate to get their hands on 2019 certificates so the fewer that are online the better."

Trump 'stabbed in back' by G7

Relations with western allies at new low on eve of summit with North Korean leader

Donald Trump's relations with his European allies sank to a new low last night as he arrived in Singapore for talks with Kim Jong-un that he said marked a "one-time shot" at peace. As he prepared to face the North Korean leader, the US president provoked another row with his western counterparts after an extraordinary collapse of diplomatic protocol at the G7 meeting in Quebec. Larry Kudlow, Mr Trump's chief economic adviser, said that the president had been "stabbed in the back" by Justin Trudeau, the Canadian prime minister, who booted the gathering.

Feder Navarro, a senior White House adviser on trade, told Fox News: "There's a special place in hell for any foreign leader that engages in bad-faith diplomacy with President Donald J. Trump and then tries to stab him in the back on the way out the door."

The dispute erupted when, en route to Singapore, Mr Trump said that he would not sign the G7 communique that endorsed "a rules-based international order" and had been agreed with the leaders of Britain, France, Germany, Italy, Canada and Japan.

President Macron of France, the European leader with whom Mr Trump has the best rapport, later accused him of "incoherence and inconsistency" and said "international co-operation cannot be dictated by fits of anger and throwaway remarks". Angela Merkel, the German chancellor, described Mr Trump's outburst as "sobering and a little depressing".

Theresa May struck a more conciliatory tone, insisting that there was no question of the US president cancelling his trip to Britain next month and saying that she had discussed the programme with Mr Trump during the summit. However, the communique she

rejoiced had been brokered in part by Mrs May's principal private secretary, Peter Hill.

Fears are growing in London that the next target of the president's anger will be Nato — an issue on which a US State Department official said that American allies were right to be concerned.

The dispute highlighted the unpredictability of Mr Trump's talks with Mr Kim. (Tomorrow's meeting on the resort island of Sentosa will be the first continued on page 2, col 3)

More than 30 fake UK universities closed by watchdog

Bogus degree-awarding institutions are on the increase, with one being no more than a shopfront and others having no physical presence at all

More than 30 fake UK universities have been shut down in the past year as concern grows about students being mis-sold fraudulent degrees.

University watchdog the Higher Education Degree Datacheck (Hedd), which monitors fake degrees, identified a total of 62 bogus institutions in the past year. So far, 32 have been closed by law enforcement and trading standards agencies, and 30 investigations are still in progress.

Fake degrees purporting to be from Scottish universities are being sold for as little as £200 online, offering students the prospect of well-paid jobs even if they flunk their courses.

Qualifications with the names and logos of some of the country's most prestigious higher education institutions, including Glasgow University, St Andrews, Edinburgh and Aberdeen, can all be easily obtained, a Sunday Times investigation has found.
