## COUNCIL OF EUROPE

Council of Europe is an intergovernmental political organisation with 47 member states, founded in 1949 by 10 European countries in order to safeguard and strengthen human rights, democracy and the rule of law on the European continent. Any European country can become a member if it accepts the rule of law principle and guarantees basic human rights for its citizens. One of the Council's most important achievements is the European Convention of Human Rights in 1950 and the establishment of the European Court for Human Rights.

## MORNING WORKSHOPS

1. ROMA IDENTITY - UCCU (4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Room A1)  
*Do you have some questions concerning the Roma but you didn't dare to ask them so far? Feel free to ask us, we will answer them! Let's talk to each other, Roma and non-Roma, let's get to know each other!*
2. VOX POP - DIA (4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Room A2)  
*Vox Pop is DIA's own debate game, with which we contribute to a debate-culture that builds on proper dialogue, real arguments, the respect of our counterparts and the diversity of perspectives.*
3. SZOCIOPOLY BOARD GAME (4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Room B)  
*The board game version of the interactive theatre play, which gives us the chance to think through the things we think, feel or presume about poverty and try them out as well during the game.*
4. HUMAN RIGHTS BOARD GAMES - EJHA (4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Room C)  
*You can try the following human rights themed board games:*

5. GETTING TO KNOW LGBTI PEOPLE - SZIMPOZION ÉS LABRISZ ASSOCIATION (Ground Floor, Nordic Room)  
*Volunteers of two NGOs talk about their own experiences as members of the LGBTI community. They demonstrate the difficulties a young LGBTI person faces in everyday life situations through their own stories.*
6. WHEN YOU DON'T EXIST... - AMNESTY INTERNATIONAL HUNGARY (Ground Floor, Room E)  
*Where are the refugees now? What happened to them? What do they go through? What does this mean from a human rights perspective and what is my role in all this?*
7. FIRST-HAND EXPERIENCE OF HOMELESSNESS - A VÁROS MINDENKIÉ/MENHELY ALAPÍTVÁNY (-1<sup>th</sup> Floor, Club Room)  
*Have you met a homeless person before? Now you can talk to them. Moreover, you can even put yourself into their shoes during this simulation game.*

## AFTERNOON WORKSHOPS

1. „EASY LESSONS” - VERZIO FILMCLUB (Club Room, -1. Floor)  
*The documentary by Hungarian filmmaker, Zurbó Dorottya dives straight into its ironic title. In the first scene, we see the protagonist, Kafia, a 17-year-old Somalian refugee, studying Hungarian. But as much as difficult this language may seem to anyone who is not Hungarian, it is actually one of the easier tasks Kafia has to face.*
2. ‘HEARTBEAT’ TEENAGERS LEARNING ABOUT ABUSIVE RELATIONSHIPS - NANE (4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Room B)  
*During the workshop participants will learn about the dynamics of abusive relationships and the early signs of abuse. We'll talk about where one can seek help in such a situation and how young people can help each other.*
3. INTERACTIVELY ABOUT CHILDREN'S RIGHTS - HINTALOVON FOUNDATION (4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Room C)  
*You'll be able to learn about children's rights through a game, you'll have the chance to try yourself out in a debate, share your opinion and ask questions about your rights.*
4. SZOCIOPOLY – INTERACTIVE THEATER – 16+ (4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Room A)  
*The play is a series of short scenes: the audience might find themselves in a hospital where they might end up being a part of the scene themselves and they can choose if they want the medicine prescribed or not. Pure luck decides what situations the viewer will be involved in.*
