STRATEGIC PLAN FOR THE BERN CONVENTION TO 2030

Request for voluntary national updates on Strategic Plan implementation

Explanatory note

In paragraph 2 of its Recommendation No. 220 (2023) on the implementation of the Strategic Plan for the Bern Convention for the period to 2030, the Standing Committee recommended that Contracting Parties:

"prior to each Standing Committee meeting, send an update to the Secretariat on any major national achievements regarding progress with the Strategic Plan such as in relation to point 1 of this Recommendation, the compilation of which will be made available to the Standing Committee for information".

The point 1 referred to, recommended that Contracting Parties:

"reflect and support relevant elements of the Vision and Strategic Plan to 2030 in and through national policies and related measures, including the National Biodiversity Strategies and Action Plans (NBSAPs), in relation to the conservation of wild flora, fauna and their habitats".

A simple format of **four main questions** is provided below to guide the provision of a brief (voluntary) update on the key implementation advances you may wish to report <u>for your country</u> for 2024. **Please return your completed questionnaire no later than Tuesday 5 November**, to the Secretariat at bern.convention@coe.int.

It is expected that the Standing Committee at its 44th meeting (Strasbourg, 2-6 December 2024) will have the opportunity to take note of the progress reflected in these national updates, and to consider any key priorities for future action.
