INFORMATION FOR IN-PERSON PARTICIPANTS

We would like to welcome you to the **Joint Meeting of the Bern SFPs Network and CMS MIKT on Illegal Killing, Taking and Trade of Wild Birds (IKB)** to be held from 7 to 9 June 2022 and **Bern Convention Group of Experts meeting** to be held from 9 to 10 June at la *Fundación Deportiva Municipal Valencia, la Petxina*, Valencia, Spain, generously hosted by the Ministry for the Ecological Transition and Demographic Challenge (MITECO) and the Generalitat Valenciana on behalf of the Government of Spain.

COVID-19:

Before the trip: Due to the COVID-19 health crisis, the Government of Spain has implemented a series of measures, including health control of passengers upon arrival in Spain. Please always verify the latest health requirements at the website www.spth.gob.es

Travelers can either present an EU COVID Digital Certificate (DCC) or a SPTH QR code (if you do not have a DCC).

Once at the airport: you must show either the DCC or SPTH QR Code that will be scanned at the health control in order to access the terminal and collect your luggage.

DO NOT TRAVEL if you have symptoms compatible with COVID-19: fever, cough, or shortness of breath, with onset within the last 7 days, or if you have been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 7 days.

On-site registration will commence at 08:30 CEST on Tuesday, 7 June. Badges will be issued at the registration desk. Please show your QR code as a proof of COVID-19 vaccination.

Field Trip:

La Generalitat Valenciana, has kindly organized a field trip that will take place on Thursday 9 June. A bus will pick up us at the venue at 13:00 CEST and take us to Pto. de Catarroja, where we will have lunch (a typical paella will be served, and a vegetarian version will also be offered). After lunch, we will enjoy a birdwatching boat trip around the [Albufera lake](#) and a visit to the Wildlife Recovery Center El Saler. We will be returning to the venue around 19:00 CEST. If you plan to return on 9 June, please plan your flights accordingly.

Adequate clothing such as a light hat, comfortable shoes (sneakers/trainers are sufficient, boots are not needed) is recommended, as well as mosquito repellent and sun protection.

From Valencia Airport/Menises Airport (VLC) to La Petxina Neighbourhood:

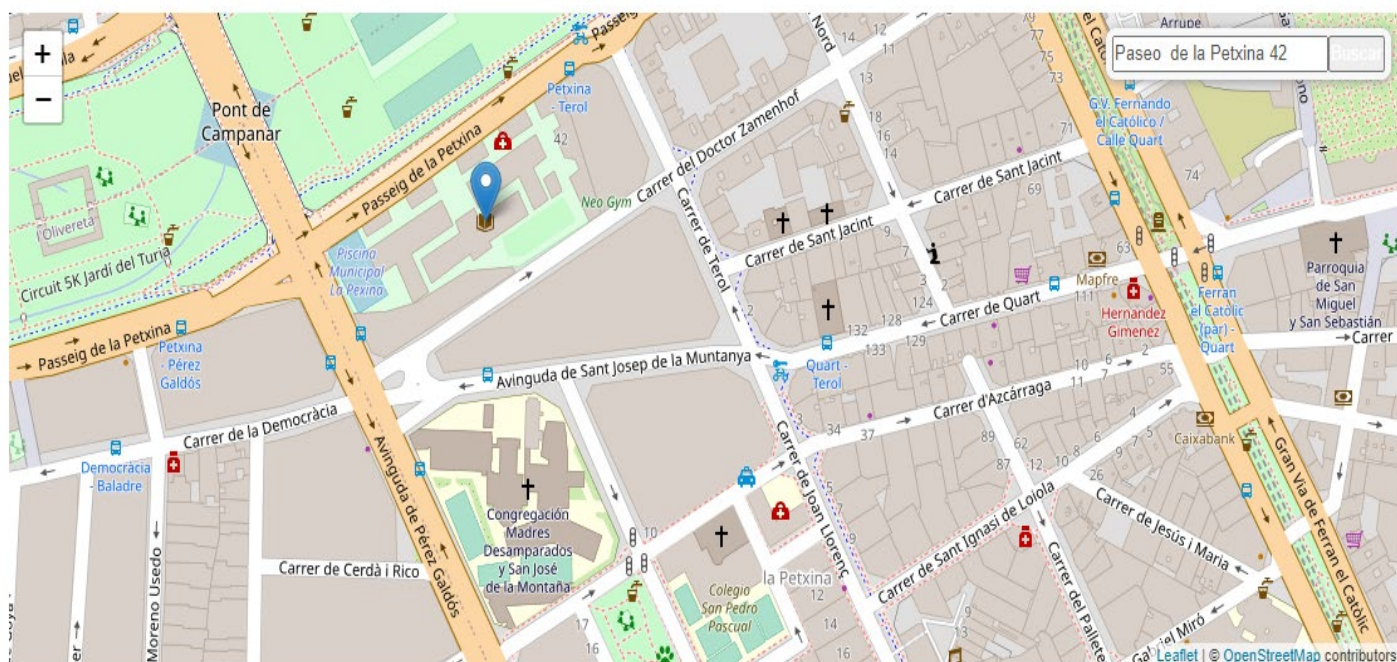

The meetings will be held **Fundaci n Deportiva Municipal Valencia, la Petxina** (Sports and Cultural complex La Petxina) at Paseo de la Petxina, 42, 46008, Valencia, Spain.

The venue: The *Fundación Deportiva Municipal Valencia, la Petxina* is located 2 km from the center of Valencia. The building, restored from the end of the 19th century, is an old municipal slaughterhouse converted into one of the banners of the city's sports facilities.



Local transport:

There are several transport options to get to the Petxina facilities:

- Subway: The nearest stations to the venue are:
 - Lines 1 and 2 of the **Turia station**. *350 meters to the venue.*
 - Lines 3, 5 and 9 the **Angel Gimerá station** *1.2 km to the venue.*
- Bus: The nearest bus stops to the venue are:
 - Line C3 bus stop **443 Pérez Galdós-Dr. Zamenhof** *250 meters.*
 - Line 95 bus stop **1424 Pextina-Ferran el Católic** *300 meters.*
 - Lines 60, 62, 64, 92 and C2 bus stop **696, Túria**. *400 meters.*
 - Line 73, bus stop **750, Sant Josep de la Muntanya - Pérez Galdós**. *400 meters.*
- Valenbisi bicycles: The nearest stations to the venue are:

The climate of Spain is Mediterranean. Average temperatures for June are between 17°C and 28°C.

Electricity:

Electricity in Spain conforms to the European standard of 220 - 230 V, with a frequency of 50 Hz. Wall outlets typically accommodate plugs with two or three round pins (the latter earthed, the former not).

Spain’s currency is the Euro. As of 1 May 2022, the exchange rate is €0.95 for 1US\$.
