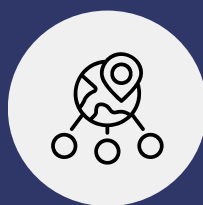

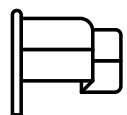


Regional harmonised approaches to monitoring access to justice for women developed with authorities and civil society, including from Ukraine



Active engagement of judicial training institutions of Ukraine with their peers of the Eastern Partnership in regional exchanges

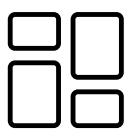
