

Inge Welbergen is a senior legal officer media at the Dutch Ministry of Education, Culture and Science. She is an expert in media regulation and is responsible for coordinating and formulating Dutch International media policies.

Inge is the representative of The Netherlands in the EU Council Working Group for audiovisual affairs, in the EU Contact Committee for audiovisual affairs and in the European Audiovisual Observatory Executive Council.
