## Introduction

This Addendum to Conclusions XV-2 published in February 20011 contains the conclusions of the European Committee of Social Rights (hereinafter referred to as "the Committee") set up under Article 25 of the European Social Charter (hereinafter referred to as "the Charter") adopted between February and April 2001, concerning national reports on the implementation of the Charter relating to the second part of the fifteenth supervision cycle, submitted by:

- Cyprus, Articles 7, 8 and 14 on 12 June 2000 (19th report)
- Cyprus, Article 11 on 11 September 2000 (19th report)

- Germany, Articles 7,8 and 11, on 14 September 2000; Articles 14 and 18, on 26 September 2000 and Article 17, on 21 November 2000 (18th report)

- Luxembourg, 25 April 2000 (4th report)
- Malta on 26 September 2000 (8th report)
- Slovakia on 11 July 2000 (1st report)
- Turkey on 3 August 2000 (7th report)

The Committee also examined the report on the 1988 Additional Protocol submitted by :

- Slovakia on 3 January 2001 (1st report)

Owing to the late submission of these reports – which were due by 31 March 2000 – the Committee was unable to include the present conclusions in the volume of Conclusions XV-2, adopted in February 2001.

A second addendum concerning Ireland will be published soon.

## Documentation available to the Committee

In addition to the documentation mentioned in Conclusions XV-2, adopted in December 2000, the Committee had the benefit of the observations of the Confederation of Trade Unions of the Slovak Republic (KOZ).
