


#### Clearance Rate by instance and by matter in 2021 (%)


#### Disposition Time by instance and by matter in 2021 (days)



# 1. Judicial organisation in Ireland (2021 data)

In Ireland, there are only three first instance courts (as legal entities) exercising general jurisdiction for the entire State (the High Court, the Circuit Court and the District Court). Each of those three courts has a single court president only, who exercises a nationwide remit for his/her court. The number of geographic locations reflects the physical location serving as seats or venues for the three jurisdictions.





The distribution between first instance general jurisdiction courts and first instance specialised courts is 60% - 40% which is somewhat different from the EU median (distribution tendency in EU: 73% - 27%).

The two specialised first instance courts listed above are Special Criminal Court No. 1 and Special Criminal Court No. 2. The latter was established in October 2015 and came into operation, sitting for the first time, in 2016. In previous cycles the category "other" (1) was referring to Special Criminal Court No. 1.

Other than distinctions between jurisdictional levels there is no specialisation - all judges within a court jurisdiction may be allocated to any category of case falling within the jurisdictional remit of the court concerned. Starting in 2013 a new cadre of specialist judges was created in the Circuit Court with specific jurisdiction in relation to certain types of personal insolvency remedy and certain pre-trial order making powers.


Ireland has a specialist regime for the trial of commercial proceedings in the form of the Commercial List of the High Court (known as the 'Commercial Court') but, as it is not a separate legal entity, being a list within and formally a part of the High Court, it is not included as a specialist court as such.






According to 2021 data, the total number of professional judges sitting in courts (all instances) in Ireland is 170, which is 4% more than in previous cycle.

More precisely, in Ireland, there are 3 professional judges per 100 000 inhabitants (this figure is below the EU median of 24 judges per 100 000 inhabitants) and about 7 non-judge staff per judge.


There is no significant difference compared with previous cycle when this ratio was at the same level of 7 non-judge staff per judge.

In this cycle, the total number of Female professional judges (all instances) is 71, which represents 42% of the total number of judges.

The total number of judges is distributed among the different judicial instances in the following way: 145 are sitting in first instance courts (of which 60 are Female); 17 are sitting in second instance courts (of which 8 are Female) and 8 are sitting in Supreme Court (of which 3 are Female).

Compared with the EU distribution of professional judges per instance, Ireland shows a larger percentage of judges in the first instance courts (85,3% compared with 72.7%), and significantly lower number of second instance judges (10% compared to 23.1%). The percentage of judges at the Supreme court level is slightly higher than EU median (4,7% compared to 4.1%).

As regards the distribution male/Female, it has to be specified that female judges represent minority in all three instances with the lowest percent in the highest instance (37,5%).



It should be noted that judges can be assigned to both criminal and civil cases. Although in some jurisdictions, mainly the High Court and Circuit Court, Judges might specialise for a period (sometimes for a period of years) in criminal and civil matters. All Judges can administer all types of cases within their jurisdiction. Administrative cases are not a separate category in Ireland.

In 2021, Ireland has 1 145 non-judge staff (of which 688 are Female). The total number of non-judge staff in comparison with the previous cycle reveals an increase of 5%.

In 2021, the number of non-judge staff per 100 000 inhabitants has slightly increased (from 21,9 in 2020 to 22,3 in 2021).

During the same period, the number of judges per 100 000 inhabitants remained at the same level of 3,3 judges per 100 000 inhabitants.

In this cycle, the non-judge staff is broken down as follows:

- 23 Rechtspfleger (or similar bodies) with judicial or quasi-judicial tasks having autonomous competence and whose decisions could be subject to appeal (among which 9 are Female);
- 892 non-judge staff whose task is to assist the judges such as registrars (of which 594 are Female):
- 196 staff in charge of different administrative tasks and of the court management (of which 79 are Female);

The discrepancies with previous data are explained by staffing fluctuations. Furtermore, it should also be specified that staff numbers in the Irish Courts Service are computed on the basis of "Full-time equivalent" resources, requiring that staff numbers include decimal points, reflecting part-time, work-sharing and other reduced time working arrangements. As decimal points are not imputable, it has been necessary to round up or round down figures.



As regards the distribution male/Female, it has to be specified that females represent majority in the total number of public prosecutors with 62,6%.







Regarding indicated total number of lawyers, it should be specified that as of 31 December 2021, there were 11,316 practicing solicitors in Ireland (5,319 male, 5971 female and 26 undefined). For the undefined classification, this is due to the Society not being provided with information on the solicitor's gender. These statistics include solicitors with a practicing certificate in the Republic of Ireland, including practicing solicitors employed by the State.

Furthermore, the information from the Law Library specifies that there is 2118 barristers (males 1354; female 764). Please note that these numbers are as of June 2021 and per the Annual Report. These figures only relate to barristers who are members of the Bar of Ireland, and do not include barristers operating outside of the Bar of Ireland.



Regarding data for Ireland, historically the number of pending civil cases has not been recorded in caseload data, as many cases initiated before the Irish courts either settle out of court or are not proceeded with by the plaintiff/applicant without there being any procedural requirement that the parties inform the court of either a settlement or an intention not to proceed with the case. Consequently, number of resolved cases appears lower and number of pending cases is not available (NA). For this reason, CR shows lower values and DT cannot be calculated which imposes limitations on the efficiency analysis. The mentioned characteristics of the system have to be taken into account whenever analysing available data for Ireland (see sections below).

Due to the above-explained reasons, no comprehensive analysis of overall efficiency could be provided.


The data on pending cases are available only for the third instance cases which allows analysis of efficiency indicators for the Supreme Court level. However, it should be noted that administrative law cases are included in the number of Civil (and commercial) litigious cases so no separate analysis could be provided for administrative law matters.

Looking at the clearance rate in the third instance, it could be concluded that this indicator was much above 100% threshold and EU medians for both civil and commercial cases and criminal law cases where Ireland recorded very high clearance rate of 131,4%. In both case types, Ireland has disposition times below EU median values, 205 days compared to 247 days in civil and commercial cases and 119 compared to 126 days for criminal cases. These two indicators imply good efficiency in dealing with cases at the highest instance.












There has been a significant increase in files received by the office in the last number of years - this is partially due to the increase in complexity of offences and investigations.


These figures were compiled by the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions and will be included in the Annual Report 2021 which is published annually on the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions website. Caution should be exercised when comparing these statistics with statistics published by other organisations such as the Courts Service or An Garda Síochána. The statistics published here may in some cases not be in line with the classification systems of other organisations.

As many of the cases are prosecuted by State Solicitors, Ireland couldn't collect any data on the status of a case between the time the direction is issued and the final outcome. This is relevant for matters on indictment. For summary cases outside of Dublin, there is rarely an information on the outcome as these directions are passed on to the police by the State Solicitor and the police execute the direction to prosecute without reference to the State Solicitor. This may change in the future if outcome data is exchange using the Criminal Justice Operational Hub. Summary cases outside of Dublin would make up a significant proportion of the files given in the figures above.

Cases are counted per prosecution file which could include more than one suspect and multiple charges preferred. Therefore, the figure given for 'Discontinued' in line 3.1 is the number of distinct files where a suspect was directed for 'no prosecution'. In some of these files, other suspects on the file may have been prosecuted in the courts.

The cases provided in line 3.4 are indictable offences.



Secretary of Judicial Council and Judicial Conduct Committee of that Committee investigate and adjudicate complaints.
