

WOMEN FORGING LASTING PEACE

Isabelle Berro-Amadeï is Minister of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation of the Principality of Monaco, a position she has held since 2022. A distinguished jurist and diplomat, she has dedicated her career to the promotion of justice, human rights and international cooperation. Prior to joining the Government of Monaco, she served for nearly a decade at the European Court of Human Rights in Strasbourg, first as Judge elected in respect of Monaco and later as Section President.

She subsequently represented Monaco as Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to Germany, Austria and Poland, while serving as Permanent Representative to international organisations in Vienna. From 2019 to 2022, she was Ambassador to Belgium, Luxembourg and the Netherlands and Head of Monaco's Mission to the European Union. She also chairs Monaco's Committee for the Promotion and Protection of Women's Rights.

Before embarking on her diplomatic career, Isabelle Berro-Amadeï served in Monaco's judiciary for over two decades, progressing from Judge to First Judge of the Court of First Instance. She has also contributed to a number of European and international bodies, including the Consultative Council of European Judges and the Ethics Committee of the Prince Albert II of Monaco Foundation.

She studied law at the University of Nice and graduated from the French National School for the Judiciary (École nationale de la magistrature).
