Question 8

Under Article 600 septies 2 of the Criminal Code - Accessory penalties, for the crimes of child pornography and child prostitution, "The conviction or application of the sentence upon request of the parties pursuant to article 444 of the criminal procedure code for the crimes provided for in this section and for the crime referred to in article 414 bis of this code results in: 1) the loss of parental responsibility, when the role of parent is foreseen as an aggravating circumstance of the crime; 2) perpetual disqualification from any office relating to guardianship, curatorship or support administration; 3) the loss of the right to maintenance and the exclusion from the succession of the injured person; 4) temporary ban from public offices; disqualification from holding public offices for a period of five years following a prison sentence of three to five years, without prejudice, however, to the application of article 29, first paragraph, as regards perpetual disqualification. The conviction or application of the penalty at the request of the parties pursuant to article 444 of the code of criminal procedure for one of the crimes provided for in this section and for the crime referred to in article 414 bis of this code, when committed to the detriment of minors, entails in any case perpetual disqualification from any position in schools of all levels, as well as from any office or service in public or private institutions or structures habitually frequented by minors".
