





[1] The total number of indicators combines the number of indicators achieved where the local JUSTROM teams could not obtain or maintain a proof as evidence (mostly signatures) and the number of indicators where the teams have evidence (signatures or proving documents). In most situations, where there is a lack of evidence, beneficiaries refused to sign the forms provided by the legal clinics because they were afraid that it could be used later on against them. The indicators where there is no proof are written in red, while indicators where there is a proof are highlighted in black. [1] Submission – refers to applications or documents submitted by lawyers on behalf of beneficiaries, at beneficiaries request
