# CENTRAL ASIA RULE OF LAW PROGRAMME 2020-2024


### Highlights

- reached and trained a total of 938 legal practitioners, including civil servants and civil society representatives;
  - Prevention of ill-treatment and torture
  - Violence against women and domestic violence
  - Rights of persons with disabilities
  - Right to a fair trial
