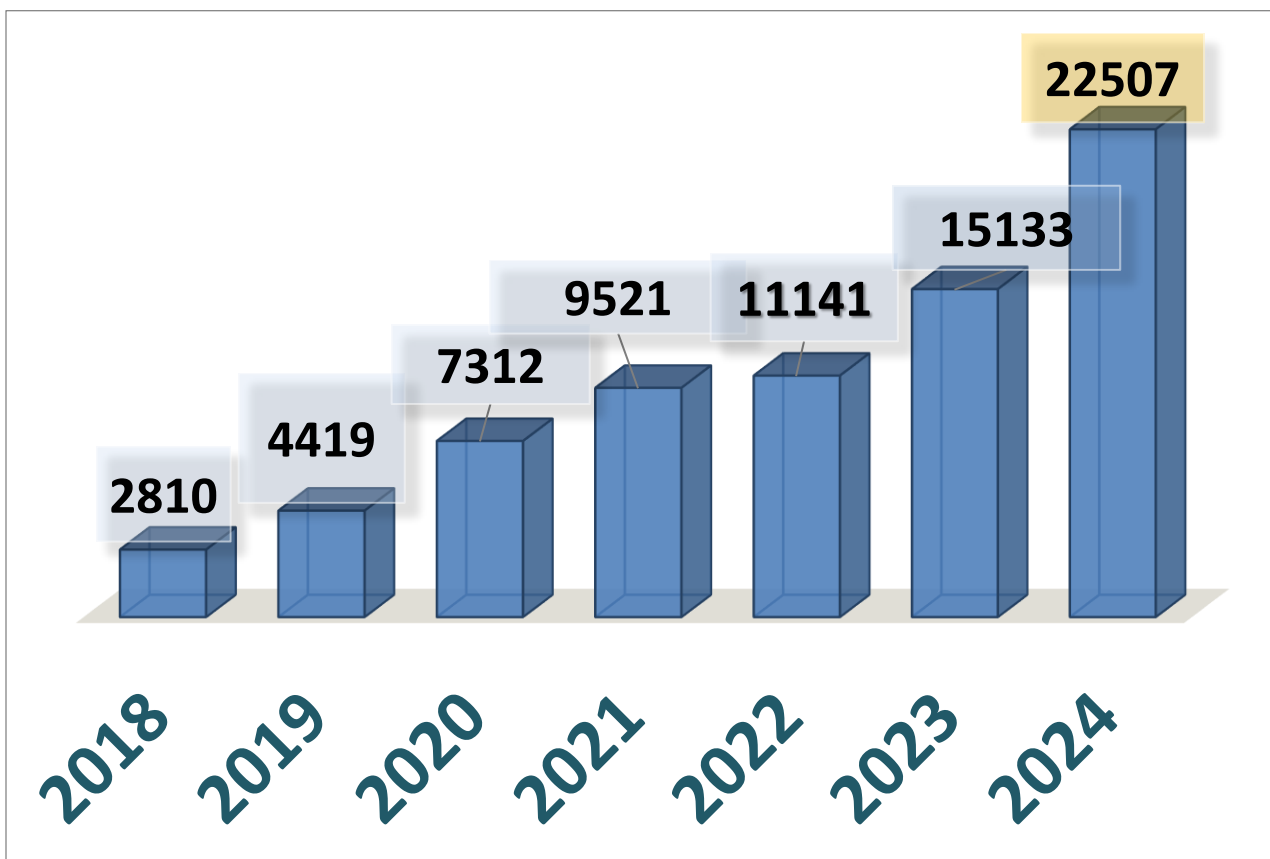

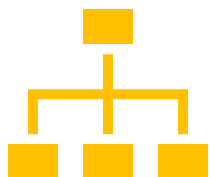

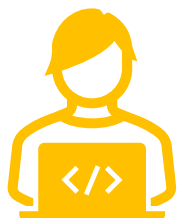

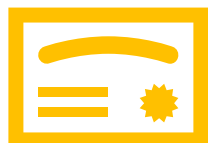




**131 translations of HELP courses in EaP languages available on the e-learning platform**



**17 841+ enrolments in self-learning courses available in EaP languages**



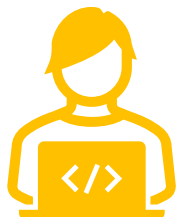

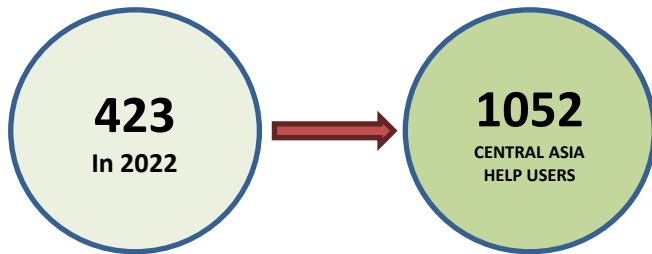

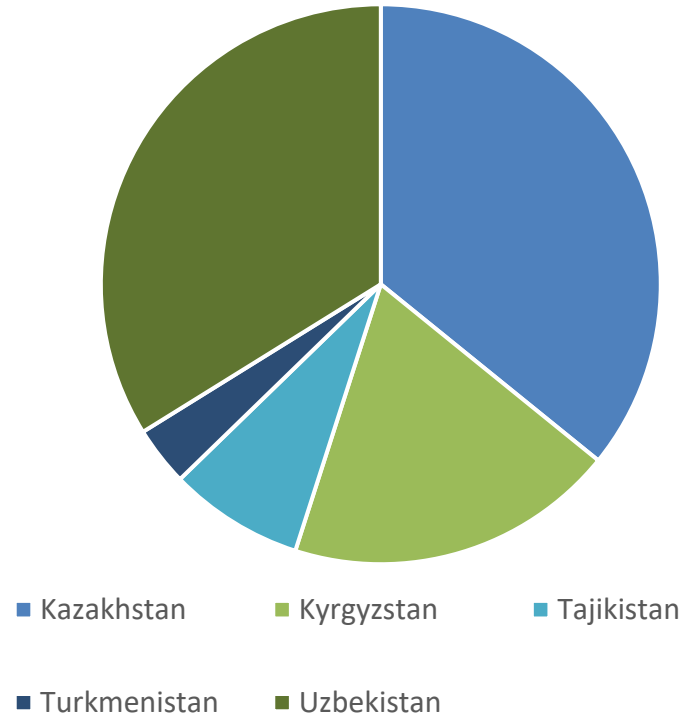

HELP courses adapted to the national context and launched:

## Kazakhstan

## Highlights

- reached and trained a total of **938 legal practitioners**, including **civil servants and civil society representatives**;
- Prevention of ill-treatment and torture
- Violence against women and domestic violence
- Rights of persons with disabilities
- Right to a fair trial

# Highlights

- **HELP courses are integrated in the in-service curriculum** for training of prosecutors and law enforcement officials **within the Law Enforcement Academy of the Republic of Uzbekistan and Academy of GPO in the Republic of Kazakhstan;**
- HELP is recognised as a tool for training of legal professionals within the National Action Plan of the Republic of Uzbekistan on Human Rights Education
