Media coverage is critical for the success of sport

- Relationships generally regulated contractually
- Reliance on "house" rights
- Use of accreditation (access) agreements
- Contractual freedom in the grant of rights
- Balance between exclusivity and access
- Dependence on enforceability of rights

The online world has brought new challenges to media and contractual "freedoms"

- Social Media
 - Disinformation
 - Hate speech
 - Racial abuse
- Piracy
 - Social media, websites, apps, IPTV
 - Primary challenge: The value of sport lies in the live dimension

FIFA's World Cup social media protection service

- Monitor and moderate hate speech on social media
- All players from 32 participating teams being offered service
- Protecting both players and their fans from online abuse during the tournament
- Social media accounts of all participants scanned for abusive, discriminatory and threatening comments
- Reported to social networks and law authorities for action against rule-breakers

There may be rules, but are they enforceable?

- "Expeditious" removal of illegal content
- "Notice and Take-down"
 - 2019 European Commission (EC) Declaration on Sport Event Organisers
 - 2021 European Parliament Resolution on challenges of sports events organisers in the digital environment with recommendations to the EC
 - 2023 EC Non-binding "Recommendation" on piracy of live content

An effective, legally binding remedy is still required!
