I joined the Congress in 2016 and served one mandate on the Monitoring Committee as a substitute member of the UK delegation. During this time I was able to attend most plenary sessions and monitoring committee meetings.

During the mandate that finished in 2025 I was a full member from the UK delegation representing the Local chamber as a member of Runnymede Borough Council in the south of England. I am currently a co leader of this Council in an Alliance with the Greens, Liberal Democrat and Labour groups and this has proved to be a good alliance with positive results.

Throughout this mandate I served on the Governance Committee with a high level of attendance. In 2024, I was a rapporteur on an opinion on the Circular Economy and was later asked to give a presentation on this topic to the United Nations conference on Urban Housing in October 2025.

I am an Independent Councillor and Co leader of my council and was first elected in 2000. I have served both in opposition and now in administration.
