Dikh na bister UA-2020/ Look and don't forget

The project will raise awareness among young people about the Roma genocide in order to increase solidarity among Roma and non-Roma representatives of civil society and to raise awareness about the xenophobia and intolerance, as well as finding possible forms and means of countering them. Actualisation of the topic of Roma genocide among young people is an important step in activisation of historical preservation activities. It can also serve as a bridge to the formation of a deeper understanding of the phenomena of xenophobia and romophobia in the current conditions of escalation of manifestations of right extremism and will help in the process of finding qualitatively new forms and methods of combating them.

Participants: Roma and non-Roma youth aged 18-30 years old: activists, artists, cultural managers, students, journalists who want to learn more about the history of the Roma people and the Roma genocide during the Second World War, have a clear motivation and desire to use the knowledge acquired in the project in their further professional or community activities.
