Minor Protection (Alternative Care) Act (Chapter 602 Laws of Malta)

9(2) Without prejudice to any other provision of any law and to his professional obligations which hold true notwithstanding this article, any professional who has knowledge of an act causing or which may cause significant harm on a minor as defined in sub-article (4) or which constitutes a criminal offense on a minor, or has knowledge that a minor is in need of care and protection shall immediately report to the Director (Child Protection) or the Executive Police and **no such reporting made in bona fide may constitute a criminal offence or give rise to any right of action under any law whatsoever:**
