## Question 3.c.

- 204A. (1) Whosoever -(a) with violence, threats, coercion or force compels a person under age into prostitution or into participating in a pornographic performance, or (b) knowingly makes any gain or derives any benefit from the conduct referred to in paragraph (a), shall, on conviction, be liable to imprisonment for a term from six to twelve years
- (2) The punishment for the offence in sub-article (1)(b) shall be increased by one or two degrees, with or without solitary confinement, if any one or more of the following circumstances results:
- (a) when the offender wilfully or recklessly endangered the life of the person under age;
- (b) when the offence involves violence or grievous bodily harm on such person;
- (d) when the offender abuses of a recognised position of trust, authority or influence over the person under age.
