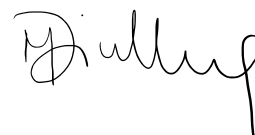
Since March 2021 I am a member of the Social Inclusion Committee and I contributed actively to its work. In recent years I have been rapporteur on various reports such as:
