## Initiative’s overview



Objective: increasing capacities and co-operation to counter hate crimes, online hate speech and disinformation about groups targeted, by using human rights and fact-based narratives



Duration: 5 years, from June 2025 to May 2030



Target groups: public authorities and civil society organisations in Beneficiary and Donor States

Co-operation activities between key stakeholders supporting those targeted by hate speech & hate crime;



A concept for a manual on effective investigation and prosecution of criminalised hate speech;



Concepts for training programmes to prevent and combat online hate speech and hate crimes;

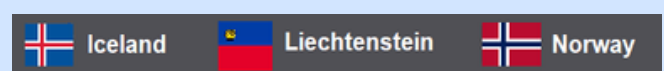
