Turkey: Degradation of nesting beaches in Fethiye & Patara Specially Protected Areas

Fethiye & Patara are among the most important sea turtle nesting beaches in Turkey



Patara Specially Protected Area





Patara Recommendation No. 182 NOT fully implemented


- 1: Nesting beach receives legal protection & management → No improvement in management, info needed on re-zoning
- 2: Define fines for non-compliance → yes but not enforced
- 3: Adequate resources for control, management & enforcement → No management personnel on site to enforce regulations
- 8. Long-term conservation programme with adequate manpower for entire beach & season → One-season, insufficient manpower



Patara Rec. 182 / 2 (ii): Regulate extent & use of beach furniture, ensure removal from nesting zone at night

Sunbeds & boats remain in the nesting zone at night

Approx. 100 parasolş for users to place as they wish.



No zoning along 90% of nesting beach Zoning incorrect in main beach



<u>Patara Recommendation No. 182 /9 :</u> Improve information, awareness, zoning

→ Signs insufficient, no zoning
Only 2 points of information across 12 km nesting beach



→ Uncontrolled vehicle access at 3 of 4 entry points



Patara Rec. 182 / 2 (iii): Prohibit vehicles access, place barriers

PATARA REC. 182. 4: Prevent uncontrolled human settlement

Patara Recommendation No. 182 NOT fully implemented

- 2: Prohibit illumination of beach -> minor sources remain

 No horse riding on beach -> horses for rent at top of dune

 No nearshore fishing with nets -> observed
 - No camping (beach, riversides) -> observed on river mouth
- 5: Litter periodically removed -> more in comparison to 2020
- 6: Address predation -> nests predated/unprotected
- 7: Ensure nest fencing -> not in some high human presence areas
- -> Illegal sand extraction: 3-5.000 trucks (press reports)




FETHIYE REC. 183/1: Stop Further Development "Small Beach": PRISTINE NESTING SITE DESTROYED



Municipality's new Beach Café:

- ✓ Permanent structures
- ✓ Lawn & new plants on sand
- √ 100 sunbeds, day & night
- ✓ Roped swimming area & raft in the sea
- ✓ Light pollution at night



FETHIYE REC. 183/ 2: Remove structures & restore sandy areas





Fethiye SPA. Çalış beach.

Sunbeds, parasols, pavilions, walkways, astroturf carpets & cushions on nesting beach that are <u>not removed at night</u>.

Note nests (red circles)

FETHIYE REC. 183/5: Map & zone the whole coast. Enforce beach furniture night removal/stacking.




FETHIYE REC. 183/6: Prohibit furniture, structures or facilities on the sandy zones of Akgöl beach

2020 facility built on sandy nesting zone!

- **✓** Cafeteria
- √ lifeguard tower
- **√umbrellas**
- √100 sunbeds, walkway not removed at night

FETHIYE REC. 183/7: Reduce light pollution



FETHIYE REC. 183/8: Permanent road barriers, designate parking & picnic areas away from beach



FETHIYE REC. 183/15: Improve information

Overall lack of signs



- Across 8 km coast there are only 7 signs (red arrows)
 - > 2 sections have no signs
 - ► Information on signs in Çalış & Akgöl is very limited
 - Information desk removed



Fethiye Recommendation 183

- 3: Stop sand extraction → Sand moved/piled
- 4: Remove planted vegetation → No Action, new plants
- 9: Regulate maritime traffic, mark corridors → No Action
- 10: Long-term research/ conservation with adequate manpower. Assess light pollution, disturbances, predation → lack of manpower, no info on studies
- 11: No camping & bonfires → Observed; time limits for beach bars → not controlled, night weddings & parties
- 12: Clean beach & sewage not discharged into sea → some litter, 1 polluted drainage channel
- 13: Enforce adequate regulations, fines → enforcement severely lacking
- 14: Ensure adequate resources for control & management → No local unit
- 16: Protect all nests with cages → Some not caged. Nests predated, few protected

Fethiye Recommendation 183 (2015)

NOT implemented 6 years since adoption!

Sea turtle habitat in Fethiye "Specially Protected Area" remains unmanaged & inadequately protected

Is the coastal zone of Fethiye considered a "protected" area by the authorities?

Why is destructive development permitted in complete disregard of the Bern Convention's Recommendation?

Majority of measures under Recommendations 182 & 183 (2015) NOT implemented

We call upon the Standing Committee to:

- > Follow-up & keep the case file OPEN
- ➤ Urge Turkish authorities to submit & implement a comprehensive action plan before April 2022.
- > Request full update on each Recommendation, plus:
 - > Patara re-zoning maps; management plan
 - Fethiye spatial plan; timeline of judicial process& demolitions; beach furniture mapping /zoning (183/5)
