

1 June 2021: An artistic workshop marking the Children's Day will take place in Cahul

The aim of the event is to mark the Children's Day through drawing activity with children, teachers of the School of Fine Arts for Children from Cahul, but also with their parents.

William Massolin, the Head of the Council of Europe Office in Chisinau, and the representatives of the School of Fine Arts for Children from Cahul will deliver welcome addresses (15.00), which will be followed by the presentation of the hotline "Child's Phone" 116 111, where children could call and receive help and counselling. Children will learn more about protection measures against abuse and the need to report such cases.

At 15.50 over 40 children of different ages from the School of Fine Arts for Children from Cahul will participate in an artistic workshop of drawing with chalk in the Square "Horelor" of the town Cahul. Children will be guided by teachers of the School of Fine Arts. At the end of the activities, children will be given gifts: supplies, balloons, sweets, information materials.

The event will be organized as part of the project "Combating violence against children in the Republic of Moldova", which is implemented by the Council of Europe Office in Chisinau. The project aims to inform society in general and children in particular about the risks of child abuse, including in the digital environment, and to increase the effectiveness of the child protection system against child abuse.

All interested media representatives are invited to the event.
