Media regulatory authorities and media pluralism

The publication "Media regulatory authorities and media pluralism" is a result of co-operation among media regulatory authorities from the Western Balkans. It aims to contribute to a wider understanding of the concept of media pluralism, its institutional and policy-related importance and the fundamental role of media regulatory authorities in this field. It analyses issue of media pluralism through the prism of European standards, legislative and institutional frameworks, existing practice and proposed measures towards the enhancement of diversity.

The publication will serve as a basis for numerous further activities of not only media regulators but also other relevant stakeholders, contribute to adequate application of European standards and best practices, leading to improvements in the media sector in the region.

This is the third publication developed through the joint efforts of European Union and Council of Europe projects and media regulatory authorities from this region, previous two dealing with the hatespeech issues">hatespeech issues (2017) and protection of minors">protection of minors (2019).
