The MediaBox

— The MediaBox is a multimedia studio for parliamentarians, right next to the Debating Chamber. Using this multi-camera facility, you can record short video clips – statements or interviews – which you can:

- ▶ share the automatically generated link on social media with one click; 
- ▶ publish it on a website; or
- ▶ send it via e-mail to your contacts, constituents, journalists, etc.

And it's so easy to use!

- ▶ Use our teleprompter for filmed statements. Just send us your text by e-mail or bring it on a USB stick.
- ▶ We'll send you a link to your recorded clip, lightly edited if necessary, as soon as possible.

Media Asset Management (MAM)

— The Media Asset Management (MAM) is a tool for your communication. It provides you with access to video recordings of all debates held during plenary sessions. It is available here:

— Using this service, you can extract a clip of your choosing from any debate (your speech, for example) in the original language and:

- ▶ share on social media;
- ▶ publish on a website or blog;
- ▶ send by e-mail to your contacts or constituents, journalists, or other interested groups.

— You can also enrich your content by adding:

- ▶ summaries of adopted texts;
- ▶ a link to the video of the entire debate;
- ▶ the adopted text(s);
- ▶ the voting result;
