- reluctant to report hate speech and discrimination

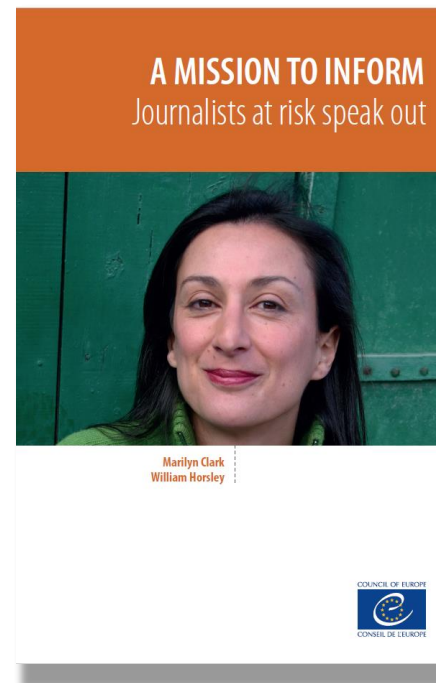
Negative trends:

- Hate Speech is increasing

Hate Speech intimidates and silences,

- e.g. Journalist & Politicians
- Sexist hate speech undermines the equal and full participation of women and LGBTI persons

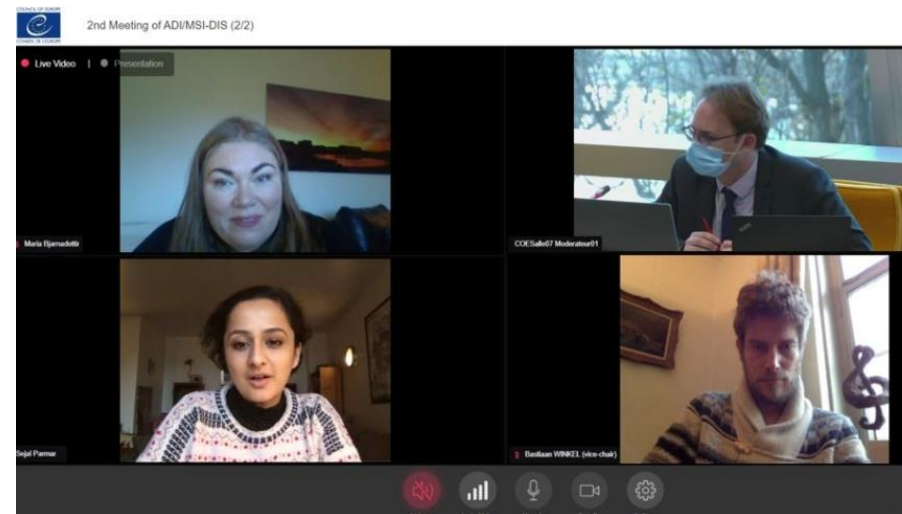

Committee of Expert on Combating Hate Speech (ADI/MSI-DIS)

- CM recommendation on comprehensive approach within a human rights framework, including in online environment.

Committee of Experts on Freedom of Expression and Digital Technologies

- CM recommendation on on the impacts of digital technologies on freedom of expression
- guidance note “legal and procedural frameworks for self-regulatory and co-regulatory mechanisms for the restriction or moderation of illegal or harmful content”.

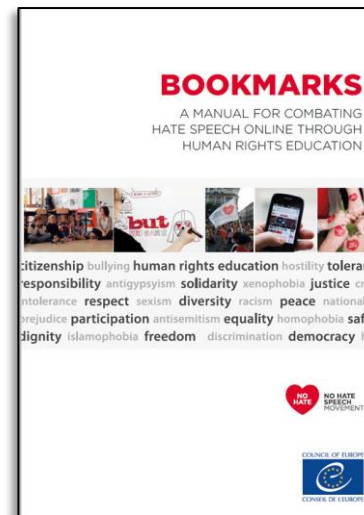

Comprehensive approach

The CM Recommendation seeks to:

- Provide a definition of hate speech for the purpose of the recommendation;
- clarify the need to identify and monitor hate speech;
- outline the necessary legal framework covering;
- criminal, civil and administrative law, including in the online environment;
- and propose non-legal measures including through
 - awareness raising,
 - education and victim support,
 - self regulation,
 - national and international cooperation and
 - coordination between stakeholders.
