General Information

Dear Participant, welcome to Chişinău! We have the honour to welcome you to the Republic of Moldova and we are pleased to provide you this practical information note on the logistical details to help you prepare for your participation in the High-Level Conference on Media Literacy and Information Integrity: Building Resilience to Disinformation and FIMI in Europe, organised by the Council of Europe under the auspices of the Moldovan Presidency of the Committee of Ministers of the Council of Europe, taking place in Chişinău, on 20 March 2026.

Travel to the Republic of Moldova

Entry into the Republic of Moldova is permitted only on the basis of a valid travel document that grants the holder the right to cross the state border of the Republic of Moldova.

The travel document must:

- be valid at the time of entry;
- have been issued within the last 10 years (this requirement does not apply to national identity cards where applicable);
- contain at least two blank pages for entry and exit stamps.

Participants are advised to verify in advance the entry requirements applicable to their nationality, including visa obligations where relevant.

Arrival and Transport

You will be arriving at the International Airport Chisinau (RMO). The journey to central Chişinău will take about 30 minutes, depending on the traffic.

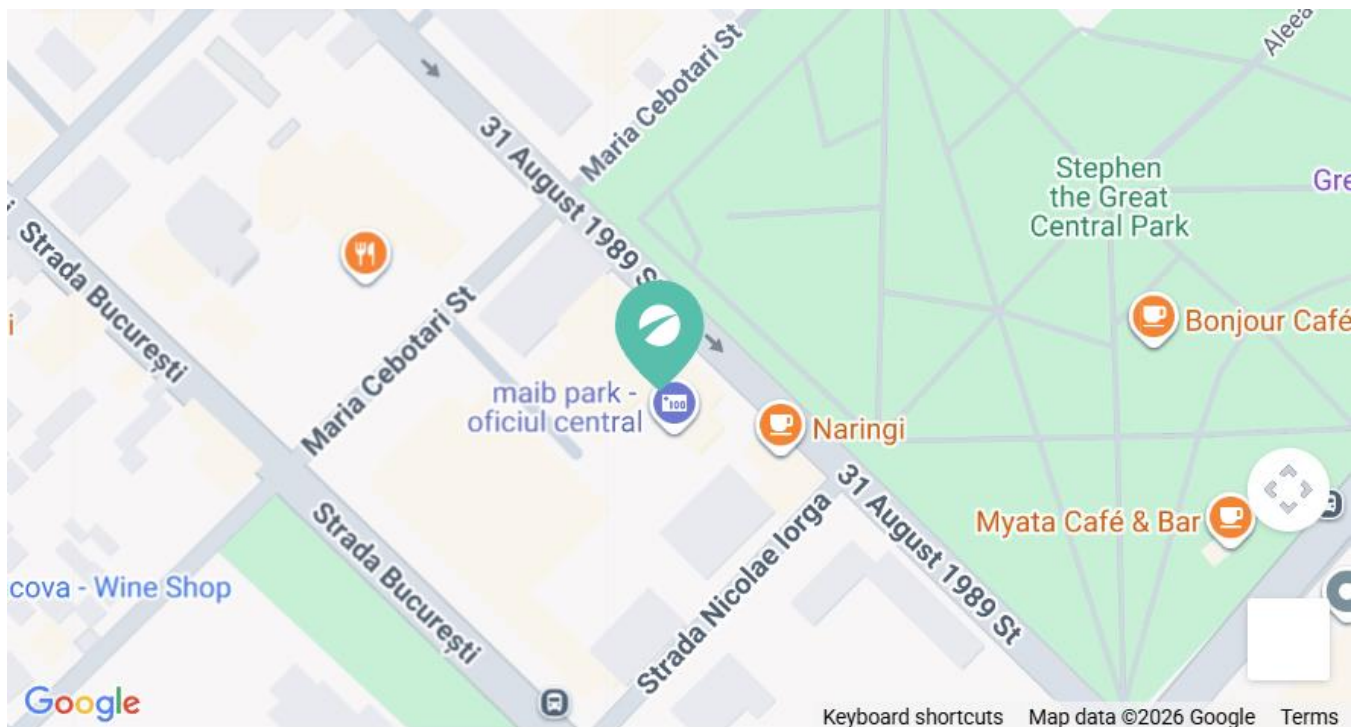

Venue

Accreditation and Badges

Participants are kindly asked to register via the online registration system provided by the Council of Europe online. The online registration system will be open until 16 March 2026.

Please note that the event will allow only confirmed participants to join. You must receive a confirmation from the Organisers prior to attending the event. **Approval of participation at the venue on the day of the event will not be provided.**

Participants should have a valid badge, which will be issued upon arrival at the venue's registration desk. To avoid delays with the issuance of badges, please arrive well in advance. The registration desk will be open on the day of the Conference from 08:00 until 09:00. The badge should be worn in a visible manner at all times, when at the Conference venue.

IT Facilities

Free high-quality wireless internet access will be available at the venue.

Interpreting Services

Simultaneous Romanian-English interpretation will be provided during the Conference.

Useful Information

1.1 Electricity voltage

The electricity supply in the Republic of Moldova is 230 volts. Standard European two-pin plugs and

sockets (Type C and Type F) are used. Devices operating on 110–120V will require a step-down transformer. Delegates are advised to bring appropriate electrical adaptors if required.

1.2 Weather in the Republic of Moldova

The climate in the Republic of Moldova is temperate continental, with warm summers and cold winters. March marks the beginning of spring and can be quite variable, with a mix of cool and milder days. The average temperature in Moldova during March typically ranges between 0°C and 10°C, though occasional colder or warmer spells may occur.

1.3 Banking Services and Currency

Moldova's official currency is "leu." Banking hours are generally Monday to Friday from 09:00 to 17:00. Some banks are open on Saturday mornings. Most internationally recognized currencies can be exchanged at commercial banks and at Chişinău International Airport.

Cash dispensing machines or ATMs are located throughout the country, and major credit and debit cards are widely accepted. ATMs are also located at some hotels.

1.4 International Dialling Codes

The international dialling code for the Republic of Moldova is +373. International calls made from Moldova should be preceded by 00, followed by the national country code.

1.5 Time Zone

The Republic of Moldova is on Eastern European Time (EET), which is two hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT).

1.6 Emergency Number

The number 112 can be used for all emergencies.
