Miriam Roache was elected President of the Organization of American States' Committee of Experts of the Follow-Up Mechanism to the Belém do Pará Convention (MESECVI) in December 2025. Throughout her tenure, Ms. Roache has played an active role in the development of key MESECVI instruments, including the Model Laws on the violent killing of women (femicide/feminicide) and on violence against women in political life. Most recently, she participated in the CEVI Working Group on gender-based digital violence, contributing to consultations and technical discussions, which culminated in the adoption of the Inter-American Model Law to Prevent, Punish and Eradicate Gender-Based Digital Violence against Women.
