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# I. Main achievements

This chapter presents short summaries of a selection of the main reforms and achievements reported in final resolutions since the Convention system was amended in 1998 by Protocol No. 11, with a clear focus on recent reforms, referring however also to important earlier developments.

In view of the wealth of cases closed, the selection concentrates on those which have led to changes of legislation, government regulations, the adoption of new policies or general guidance from superior courts. As a rule, the overview does not cover information on measures providing individual redress to applicants.

The reforms are in principle presented in the order corresponding to the thematic domains used in the specialised database [HUDOC-EXEC](#) of the Department for the Execution of Judgments of the European Court of Human Rights.

Many reforms address issues which appear to be on-going challenges in member states. The effects of reforms adopted at one point in time may thus need to be monitored and possibly revisited as conditions change.<sup>1</sup>

It is recalled in this context that the Committee of Ministers has issued [Recommendation \(2004\)5](#) on the verification of the compatibility of draft laws, existing laws and administrative practice with standards laid down in the European Convention on Human Rights.



## ▶ Right to liberty and security

Two binding legal opinions of the Supreme Court in 2017 introduced an obligation on domestic courts to clearly indicate, in rulings ordering or extending detention on remand, the existence of a reasonable suspicion that a defendant committed a crime, and to respect the statutory time-limits for re-examination of the grounds for detention.

## ▶ Functioning of justice

### ➤ Execution of final judicial decisions

By the Enforcement Act of 2011, the enforcement of final decisions was entrusted to public enforcement officers with the goal to reduce workload in courts and increase efficiency of enforcement proceedings in general. The Act included special provisions concerning enforcement of decisions in respect of child maintenance imposing special diligence.

### ➤ Remedies against excessive length of proceedings

Following amendments to Civil Procedure Law in 2015, civil and labour proceedings became more efficient, notably through the abolition of multiple remittal possibilities, the tightening of procedural deadlines and the creation of alternative dispute resolution options. Effective domestic remedies to complain about excessive length of proceedings were also introduced.

## ▶ Freedom of expression

Defamation and insult were decriminalised following amendments to the Criminal Code in 2011.

## ▶ Right to private and family life

Defective manner in which the civil and criminal-law mechanisms were implemented in response to the applicant's complaints about bullying by her prison guard colleagues. Change of domestic case-law on the required proof of ill-treatment at work due to bullying in civil proceedings for damages.

## ▶ Protection of property rights

### ➤ Suspension of pension rights

The possibility to repeal or restrict a person's acquired pension rights should he or she resume work or establish a private practice was repealed in the Law on Pension and Disability Insurance in 2008.

### ➤ Deprivation of land on the coast

In 2020 the Supreme Court revised its case-law relating to property rights in coastal zone and adopted a legal position of principle concerning the status of privately-owned land in the coastal zone.
