

Threats to Montenegrin journalist Milka Tadić- Mijović

Regarding the attack on the journalist Milka Tadić- Mijović, the Basic State Prosecutor's Office in Kotor formed the case Kt.no. 530/21 against Filipović Božidar from Budva for committing the criminal offence of endangering safety under Article 168 paragraph 1 of the Criminal Code of Montenegro.

In the criminal complaint, the reported person was charged with endangering safety of the injured party by threatening to attack her life and body, by making several threats on 16th of August 2021 at around 08:00 p.m. in front of the hospitality establishment „Kesa“ in Petrovac in the Municipality of Budva.

The suspect was deprived from liberty, after which he was questioned by the attending state prosecutor who ordered his detention and submitted a motion for detention to the investigating judge of the Basic Court in Kotor, which was adopted. The injured party- witness Milika Tadić Mijović, who described the incident in question in her statement and stated that in those critical circumstances she felt fear denied committing the criminal offence, in his defense. The case is at the stage of preliminary investigation after which a decision will be made.
