- 4. Distance-learning trainings on human rights (Help Methodology) are introduced for judges and prosecutors in Morocco

- Promoting the **HELP courses related to the human rights issues** relevant to Morocco;
- Reinforcing and increasing of the pool of trainers to train on effective investigation in line with international human rights standards;
- Translating and adapting existing guides, check-lists and materials on human rights- related relevant topics.
