**Re O'Keeffe v Ireland, 31333/2006, judgment of 28 January 2014**

Dear Mr Sundberg

I refer to the above matter.

As you are aware, the Government submitted an Action Plan on 30 September 2019 and indicated a further Action Plan would be filed on 28 January 2020.

The review of the *ex gratia* scheme, referred to in the Action Plan, remains on going. Due to other domestic considerations, it will not be possible to finalise the next Action Plan before 28 January 2020. I am instructed by my authorities to seek an extension on the date to file an Action Plan to 8 April 2020.

I would be grateful if you could acknowledge receipt of this letter and revert on the request for a short extension at the earliest opportunity.
