DURING 2023-2024 PTCU HAS LAUNCHED 5 HELP TUTORS COURSES

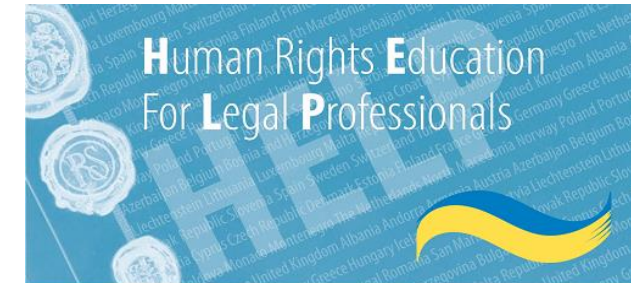

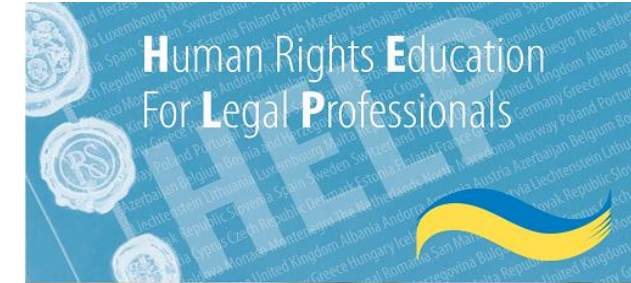

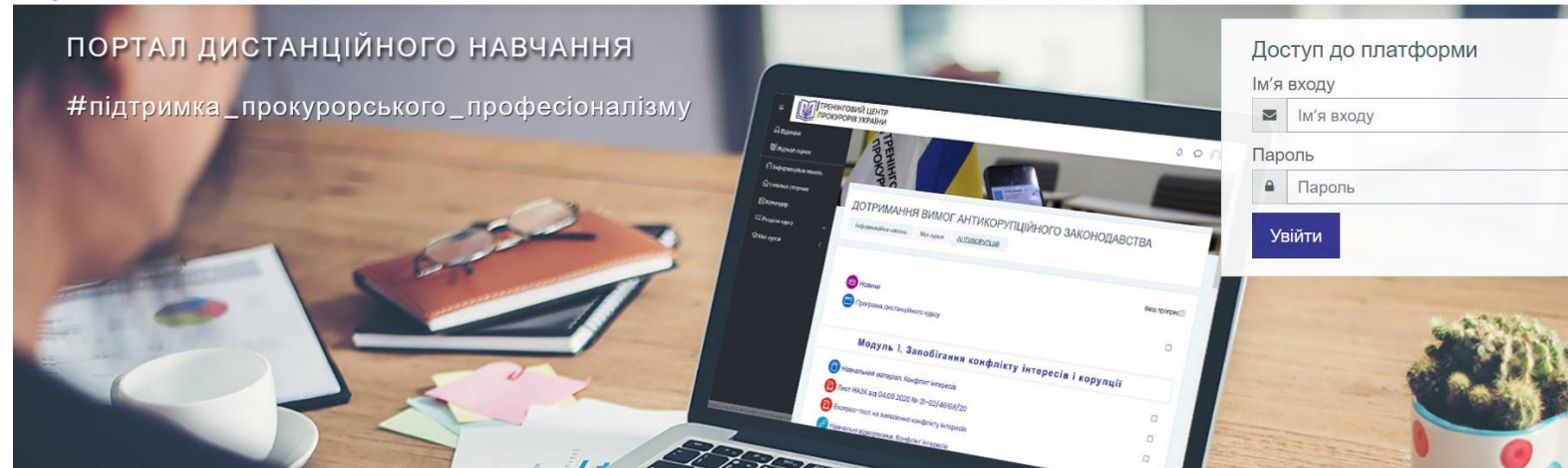
